


OIMAPS V1.0.0 beta (Organisational Interoperability Maturity Assessment for Public Services)

The OIMAPS V1.0.0 Beta is an online self-assessment tool that allows public service owners to measure the behavioural interoperability maturity of their Digital Public Services from the Organisational Interoperability viewpoint.

OIMAPS is the organisational interoperability **specialisation** of <u>IMAPS</u>.

Features

- ✓ Helps public service owners evaluate, improve and consider key interoperability
 aspects of their public service, looking at the context of their Service Delivery (D)
 and Service Consumption (C), assessing:
 - the organizational behavioural interoperability specifications of the data, information and knowledge delivered and consumed
 - the organisational behavioural interoperability capabilities that enable the delivery and consumption of services, data, information and knowledge
 - the organisational behavioural interoperability manifestations of the public service delivering and consuming services, data, information and knowledge
- ✓ Fully compliant with latest version of the **European Interoperability Framework** (EIF)

Expected Benefits

- Provides immediate insight into a public service's organisational interoperability and tailored recommendations on how to improve its organisational behavioural interoperability at any point in time throughout the lifecycle of the public service
- Measures how well different Public Administrations collaborate in order to achieve their mutually beneficial and agreed e-Government service-related goals on how their processes will interact in order to deliver public services
- Applicable to any national digital public service in the European Union across any domain from open data portals, to eVoting platforms, to public procurement services and more
