Objectives of the survey

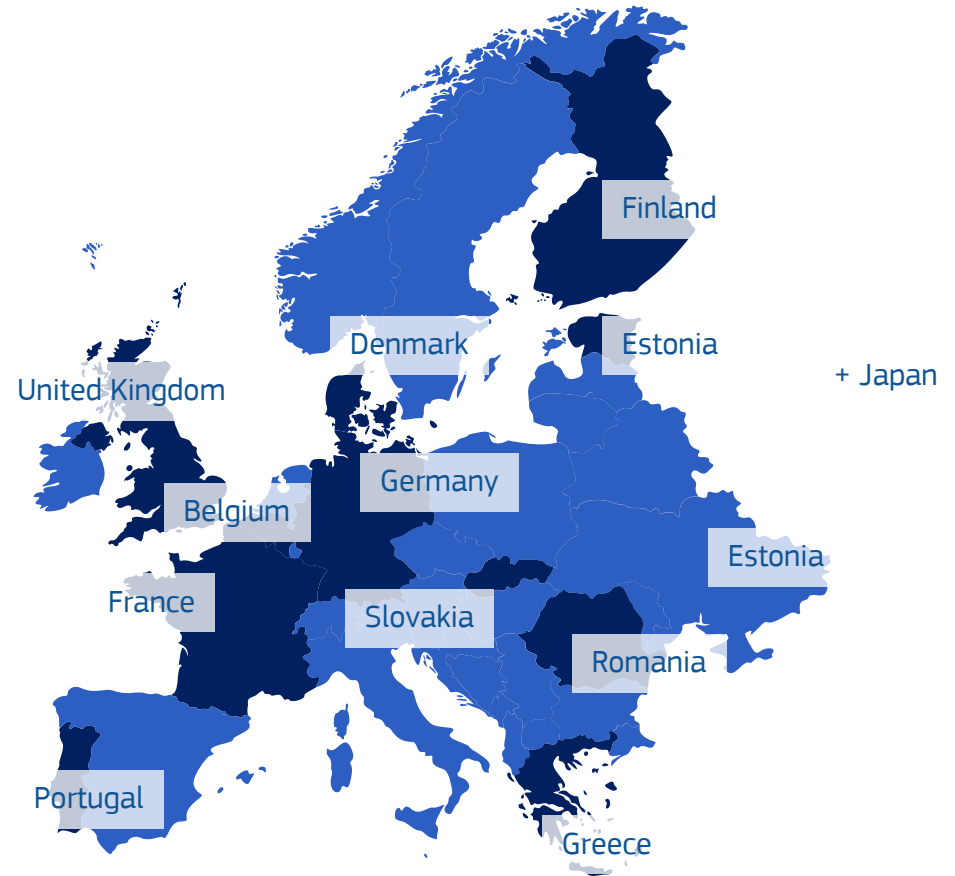
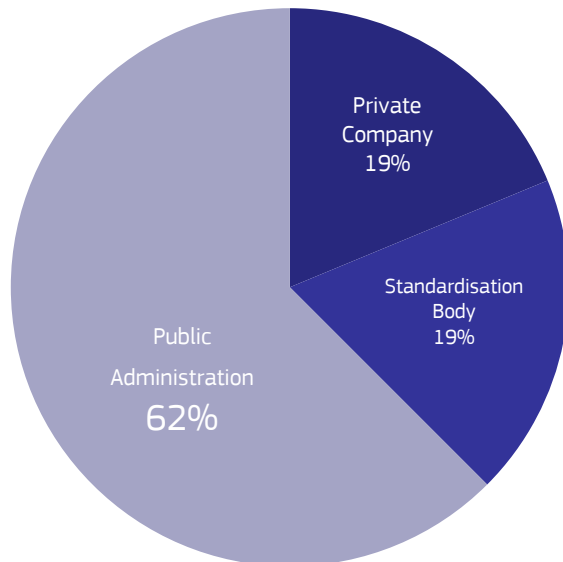
- To know more about the participants' goals in attending the event.

This report summarises the results of the CESAR Feedback Survey that was conducted after the workshop.

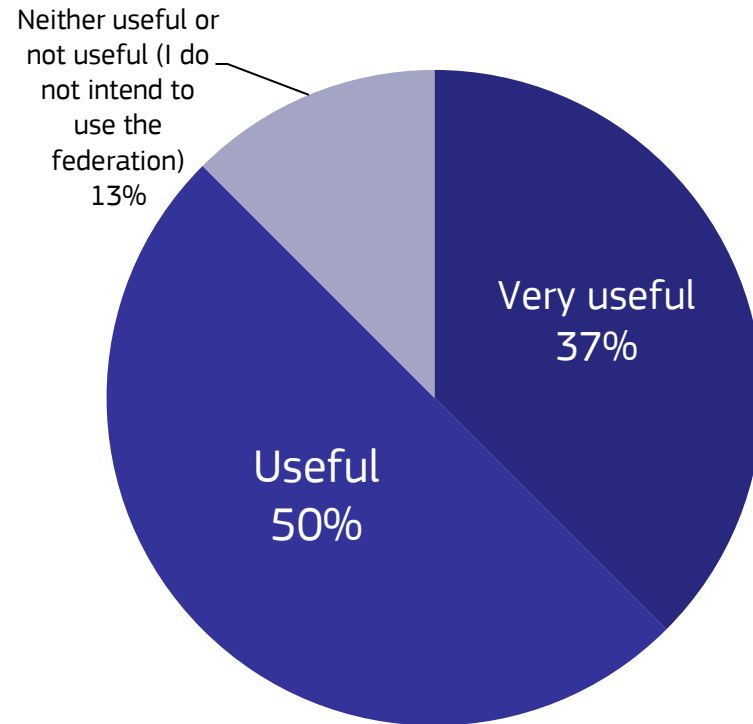

were represented ?



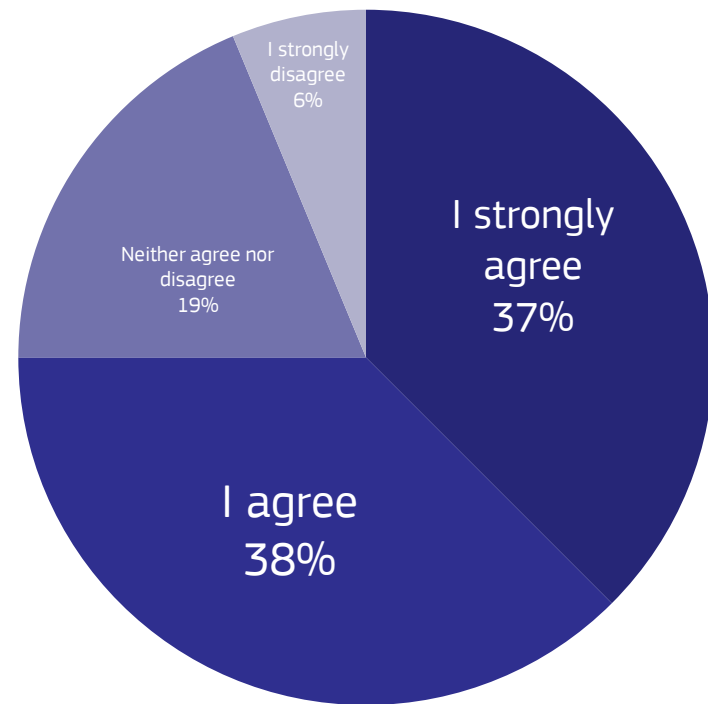
87%

(very) useful

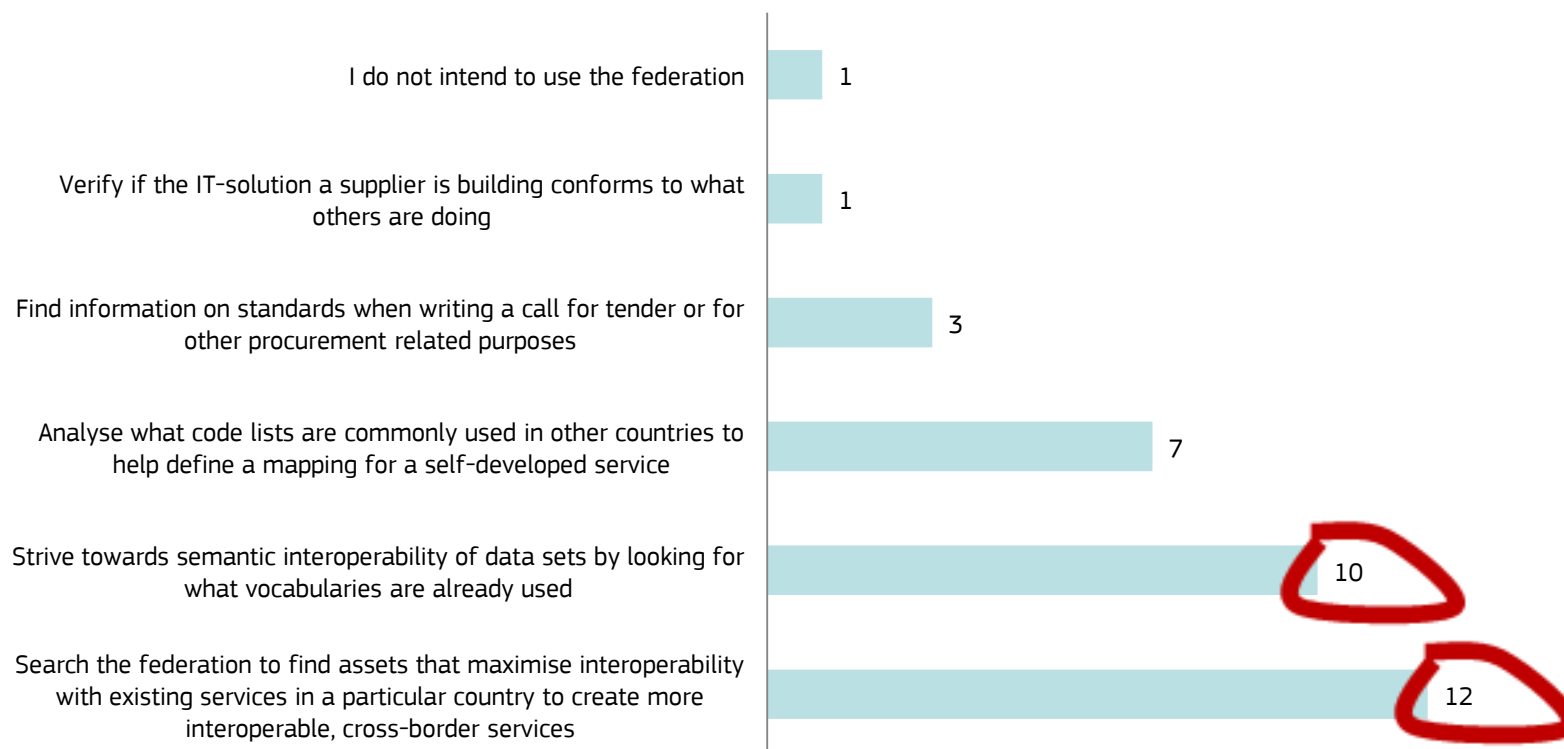

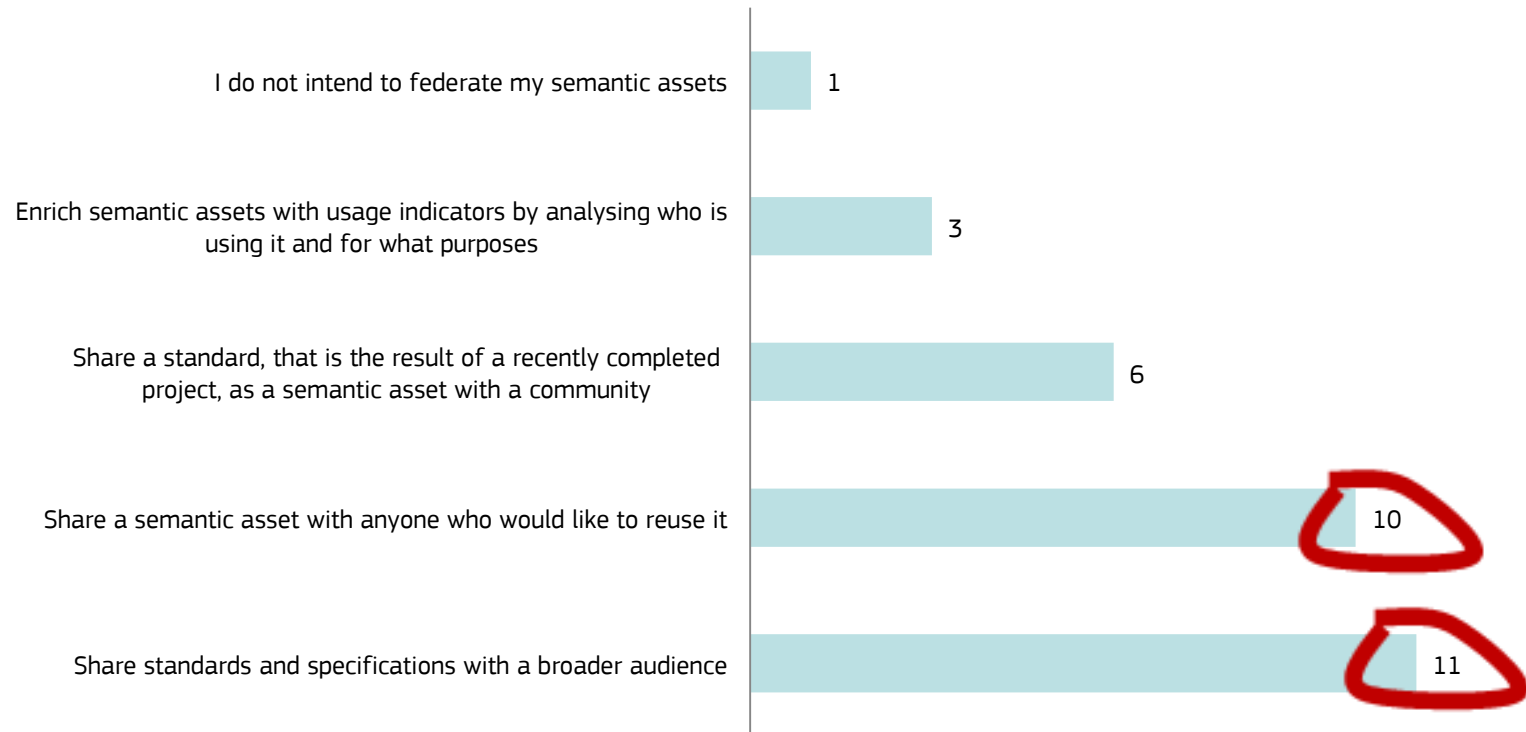

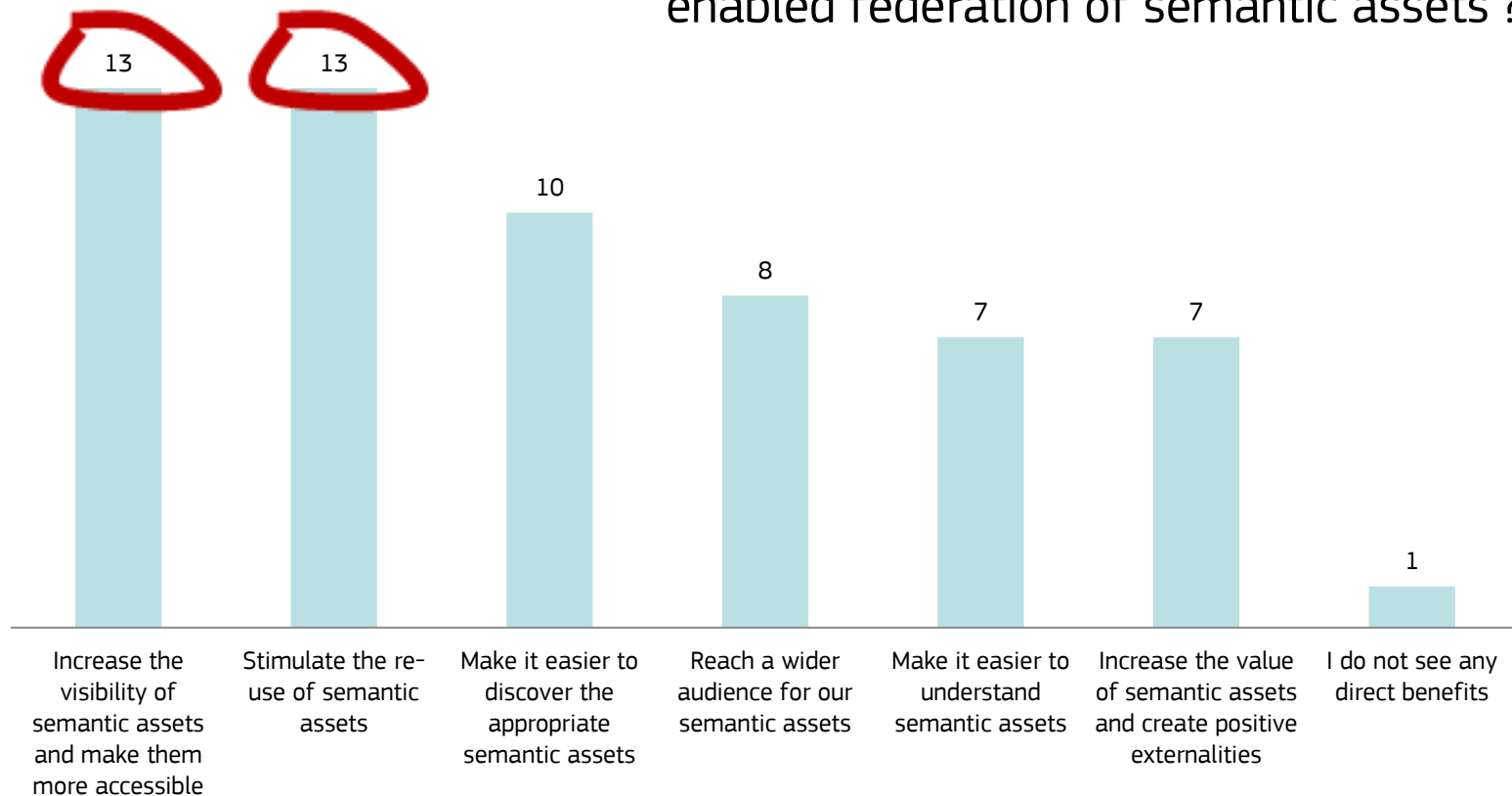
> As a [user of semantic assets](#), what are the main purposes to use the ADMS-enabled federation?



> As a **publisher of semantic assets**, what are the main purposes to use the ADMS-enabled federation?



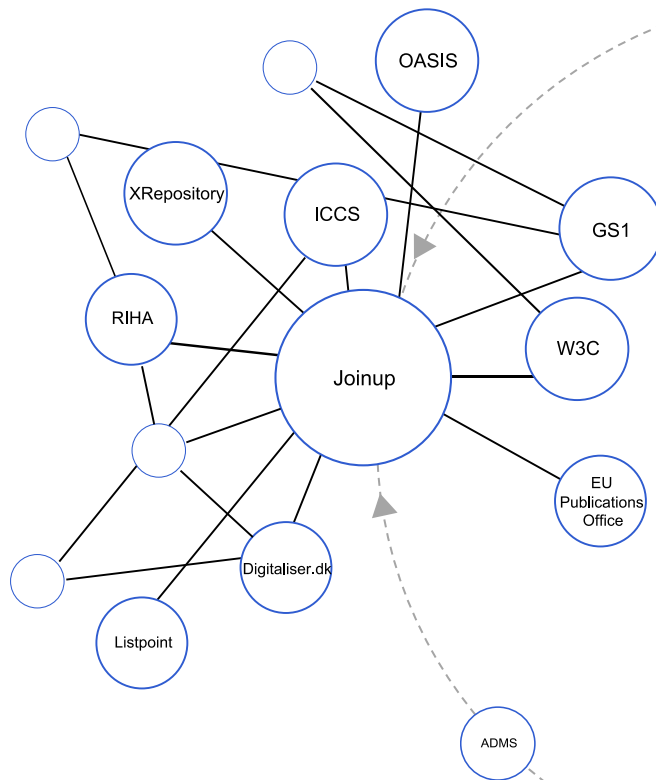
> What are the **benefits** of the ADMS-enabled federation of semantic assets ?



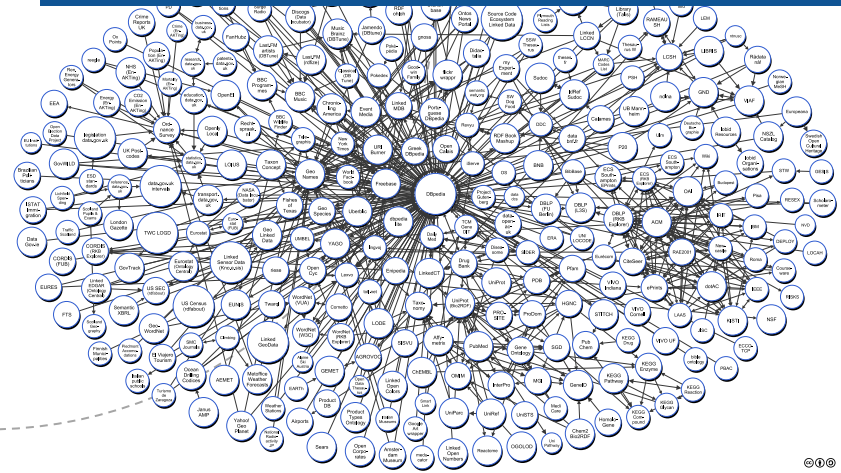
> What are the **main barriers** to onboard the ADMS-enabled federation of semantic assets ?
