1 INTRODUCTION

This analysis document specifies the rules for the validation of the postal code entered by the signatory of a citizens' initiative, for each country in the EU.

The validation rules implemented are based on Regulation (EU) No 211/2011 on the citizens' initiative and on the formats provided by the Member States.

2 POSTAL CODES

The signatory can enter a postal code with or without whitespace and punctuation characters such as slash or hyphen. All such whitespace and punctuation characters entered by the signatory are regarded as insignificant for validation purposes, i.e. validation rules ignore any whitespace and punctuation characters entered, and validate based solely on alphanumeric content.

Acceptable whitespace and punctuation characters are defined in Appendix I - Appendix I: Whitespace and Punctuation Characters

A rejection error is triggered if a field entry contains an invalid character, i.e. the entry of a character which is not alphanumeric and not an acceptable whitespace or punctuation character.

A postal code should be entered – and is validated – without any country prefix.

N.B. A postal code entry field is only shown when required by the country being signed for.

When a postal code entry field is shown, the signatory is normally¹ obliged to enter a valid postal code for their country of residence.

Key: L => Latin Alphabetic case-insensitive letter (A-Z, a-z)

N => Arabic Numeral (0-9)

- => no content needed

Length => significant length i.e. excluding punctuation and whitespace characters

2.12 Hungary

2.13 Ireland

Although a postal code is formally required for a signatory using the statement of support form for Ireland, Irish addresses do not always include a postal code . Therefore, the OCS system accepts an Irish address without a postal code.

When an Irish resident uses the form for Ireland:

- The postal code is an optional field.
- The OCS system accepts any alphanumeric² value as the Irish postal code.

When an Irish resident uses the form for any country other than Ireland requiring the entry of a postal code:

- The postal code is a required field.
 - The OCS system accepts any alphanumeric² value as the Irish postal code.
- N.B. Should the Irish resident have no postal code for their address, they may enter a dash character (-)³ or any other characters indicating that there is no postal code.

2.28 Non-EU residence

When a non-EU resident signatory uses the form for any country requiring the entry of a postal code:

- The postal code is a required field.
- However, the OCS system accepts any alphanumeric² value as the non-EU postal code. No validation rule applies.

N.B. Should the non-EU resident have no postal code for their address, they may enter a dash character (-)⁴ or any other characters indicating that there is no postal code.

The following Whitespace and Punctuation Characters are accepted as insignificant characters in an entry field for a Postal Code:

N.B. As insignificant characters, any Whitespace or Punctuation Characters entered for a Postal Code is:

- displayed when entered
- excluded from the length and accepted value for the Postal Code
- excluded from any exported PDF or XML file
