Factsheet Lithuania

Main interoperability activities

Lithuania is currently preparing for the Public Governance Development Programme 2012-2020 (PGDP) which is expected to be approved by the government by the end of 2011. One of the tasks of this programme under the eGovernment area is the creation of a national interoperability framework (NIF). The framework will use the European Interoperability Strategy (EIS) and the European Interoperability Framework (EIF) as their guidelines. It has not been communicated by when the NIF would be ready.

Summary of the NIF

No NIF has been developed yet for Lithuania.

Alignment NIF/EIF

Currently Lithuania has no NIF yet. Lithuania has concrete plans to develop a NIF for which the EIS and EIF will be used as guidelines. The NIF/EIF alignment will be made after the formal publication of the Lithuanian NIF.

Other initiatives on interoperability

Lithuanian Information system for interoperability between public administration information systems (VAIISIS)¹: The VAIISIS is a central portal which facilitates the offering of services to citizens and legal bodies from different public administrations. The strength of this platform is that it provides a single interface for the data exchange between the base registries and the information systems.

Saveikumo portalas²: A website where all information concerning Interoperability is grouped, but it is expected to be improved. This website explains a.o. what interoperability is, what the current projects are and contains links to initiatives in other countries, including the ISA programme.
