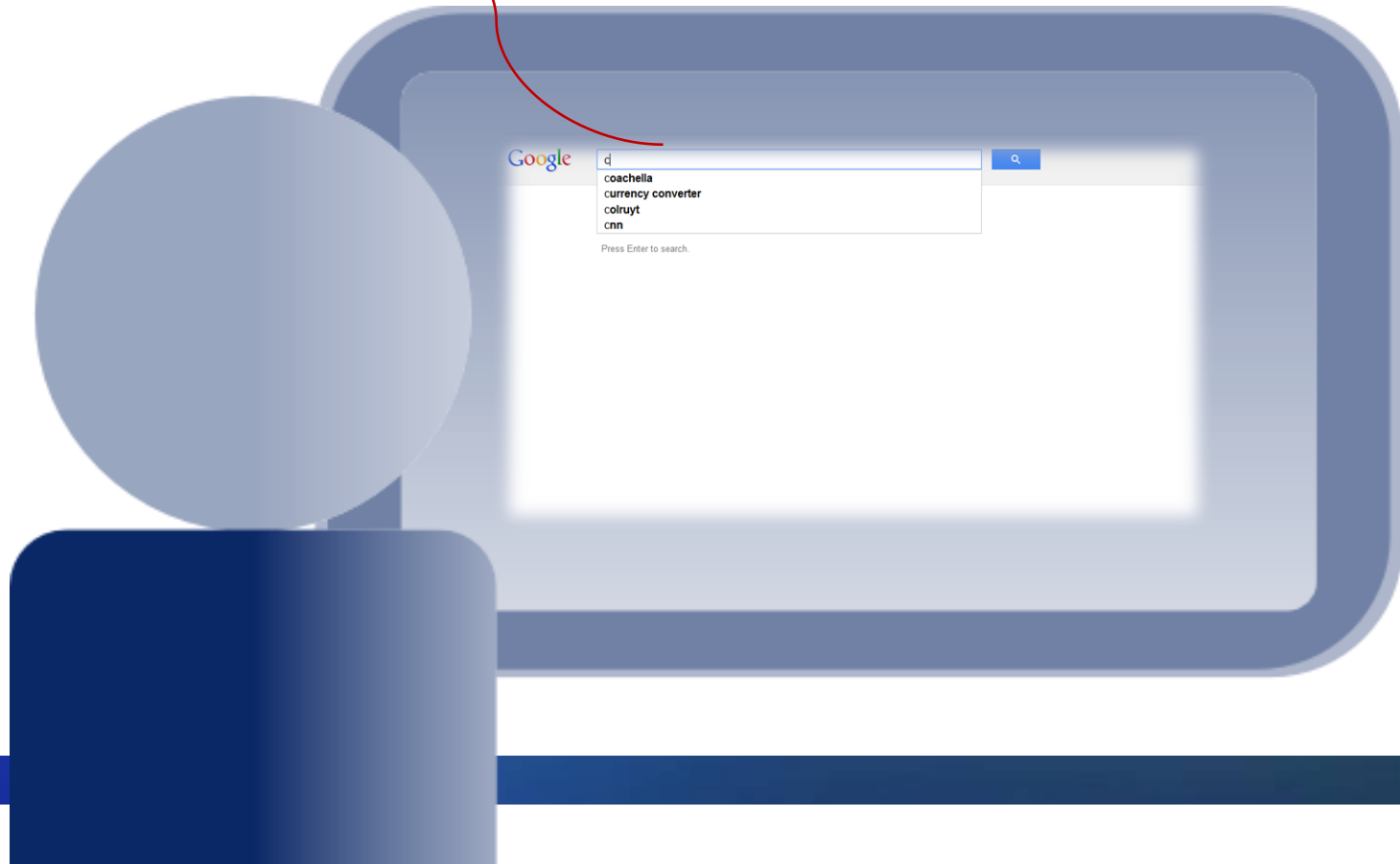

In which context is it used?

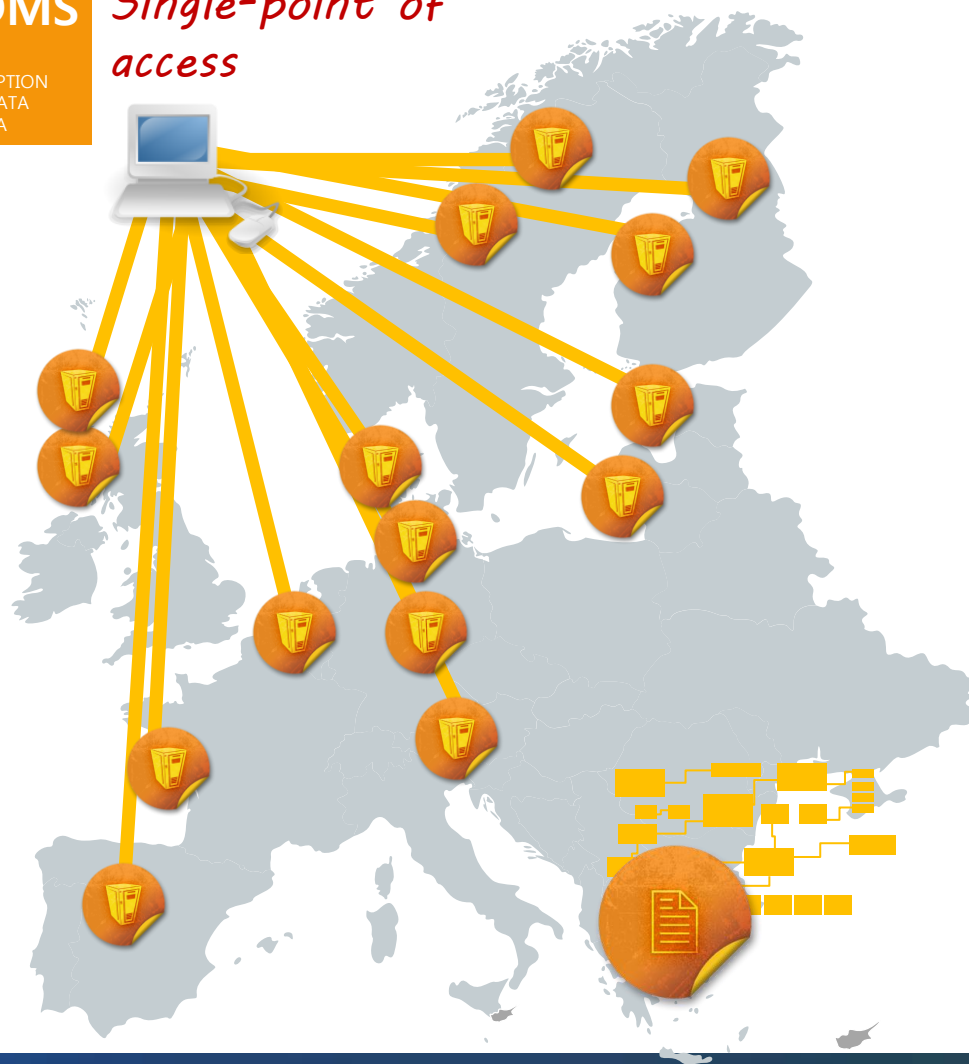


How to get overview?

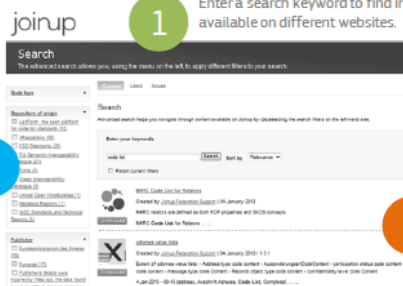
