The Technology Trasfer Centre TTC is the answer to the legal mandate established by Article 46 of <u>the spanish law 11/2007</u> <u>Citizens Electronic Access to Public Services</u> and article 17 of the <u>Royal Decree 4/2010 Regulating the National Interoperability</u> <u>Framework</u>



Article 46. Technology Transfer within the Public Administration.

GOBIERNO DE ESPAÑA

- 1. Public Administration bodies shall keep up-to-date directories of applications for free reuse, particularly in those fields which are of special interest for the development of the electronic administration and in accordance with the stipulations established in the National Interoperability Plan.
- 2. The State Public Administration, through a **technology transfer centre**, shall keep a general directory of applications for reutilisation, and shall provide technical assistance for the free reutilisation of applications and shall promote the development of common **applications**, formats and standards which are of particular interest for the development of electronic administration in the framework of the national interoperability and security frameworks.





What is the CTT?



The CTT publishes a general directory of information technology solutions interesting in the area of e-government. Its objective is to boost the reuse of solutions by all public administrations and to boost the provision and use of e-government services. This website provides information about applications, common services, semantic assets, policies, methodologies and experiences

in the area of e-government.



The CTT also allows the collaborative development of egovernment applications in a distinct technological environment named "CTT-Forge".







 A solution is a group of descriptive information pages, downloadable documents and files, news, related links etc.

* The concept of solution may refer to:

GOBIERNO DE ESPAÑA

- Horizontal services: available to any public body or administration with the aim to simplify e-government implementation of new services and foster interoperability.
- ICT Developments implemented by a public administration whose source code and related information is offered to other administrations. This administrations can use or even can improve this software.
- Semantic Assets for the definition of data models or interfaces.
- Any technology project implementation. Other organisations and bodies can profit from its description and its implementation and use experience.
- Recommendations, policies, methodologies linked to E-Government.
- * Many of these solutions are related to interoperability.







Horizontal Services

* SVD. Data verification System.

- Public Administrations can connect to the system (using webservices) to check data related to citizens such us: identity number, place of residence, payment of taxes, scholar degrees, etc. Citizens don't have to provide this information (already managed by a public administration) but allow a specific public body to check it.

- Service offered to all public administrations to verify digital signatures (among other services) from different certification authorities.

- It's offered as opensource with a EUPL licence and it is also provided as an horizontal service to public administrations.
- * AWR. Electronic Registry Application

 - Software developed to manage Spanish Electronic Registry Offices which stores each registry asset as specified in the National Interoperability Framework
 - It's offered as opensource with a EUPL licence

 - Methodology to explain how the risk analisys of information systems should be done.


* Catalogue of Standards of the NIF
