- The creation of issues in joinup for the "optional validation rules", "including Croatia in OCS" and "changes in the Annex III" is still outstanding.

Issue #	Issue name	Comment
64532	User interface for downloading exported statements of support	Running several export in parallel won't be allowed (export button will be disabled until previous export completes).
64537	Export statements of support into a single ZIP file	 No cancel button after the launch of the export. All the exported files for a country will be zipped in a single file; and all the country zips will be included in a single export zip file. After the changes in export are implemented, performance tests will be run in 2 configurations: GlassFish/MySQL and Weblogic/Oracle.
62896	Handle 'HEAD' requests	This seems to be a low priority request.
61476	Enable interface customization without jeopardizing certification	There are 2 possible approaches that will be submitted to the Change Management board for final decision.
