The service portfolio is used to manage the entire lifecycle of all public services, and includes three categories: service pipeline (proposed or in development), service catalogue (live or available for deployment), and retired services.</li> <li>The Business Lifecycle: The Business Lifecycle is the Lifecycle of a business from its creation until its termination. It is comprised of different stages a business can be in during its existence.
