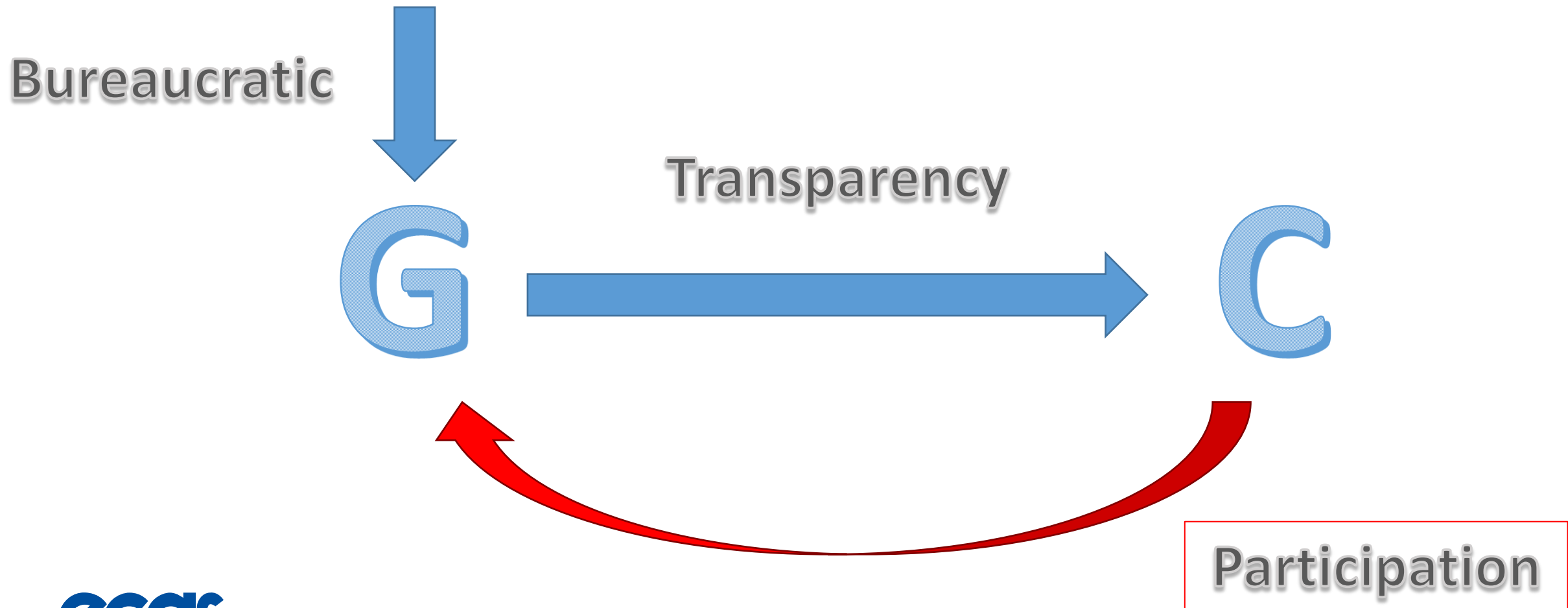

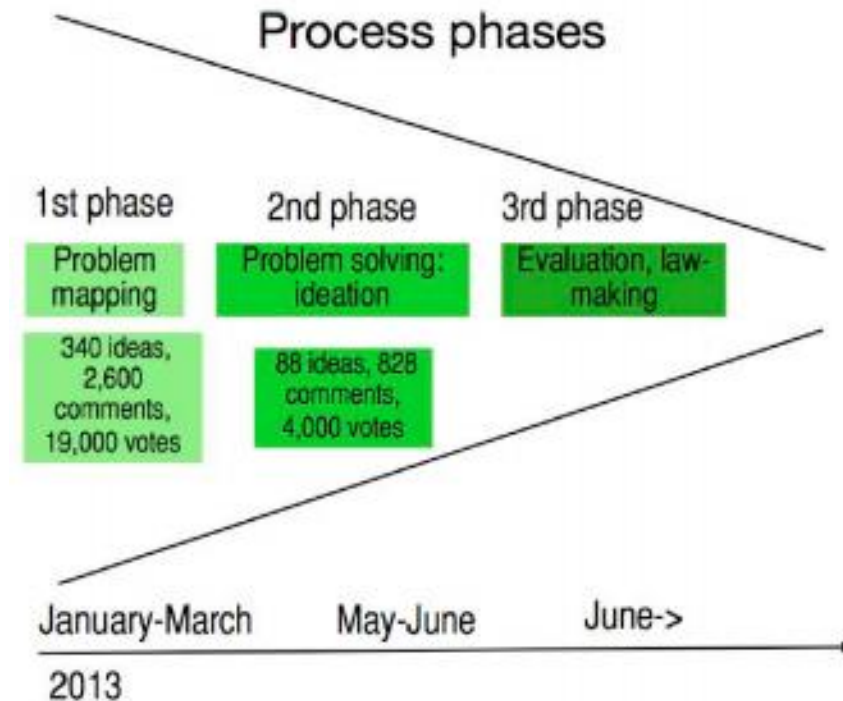

# Case Study: Open Ministry in Finland

- ★ Step 1: Finnish Parliament adopted the New Citizens' Initiative Act (50,000 signatures in six months would lead to a discussion in Parliament)
- ★ Step 2: Open Ministry was launched
- ★ Example: Off-Road Traffic Act
