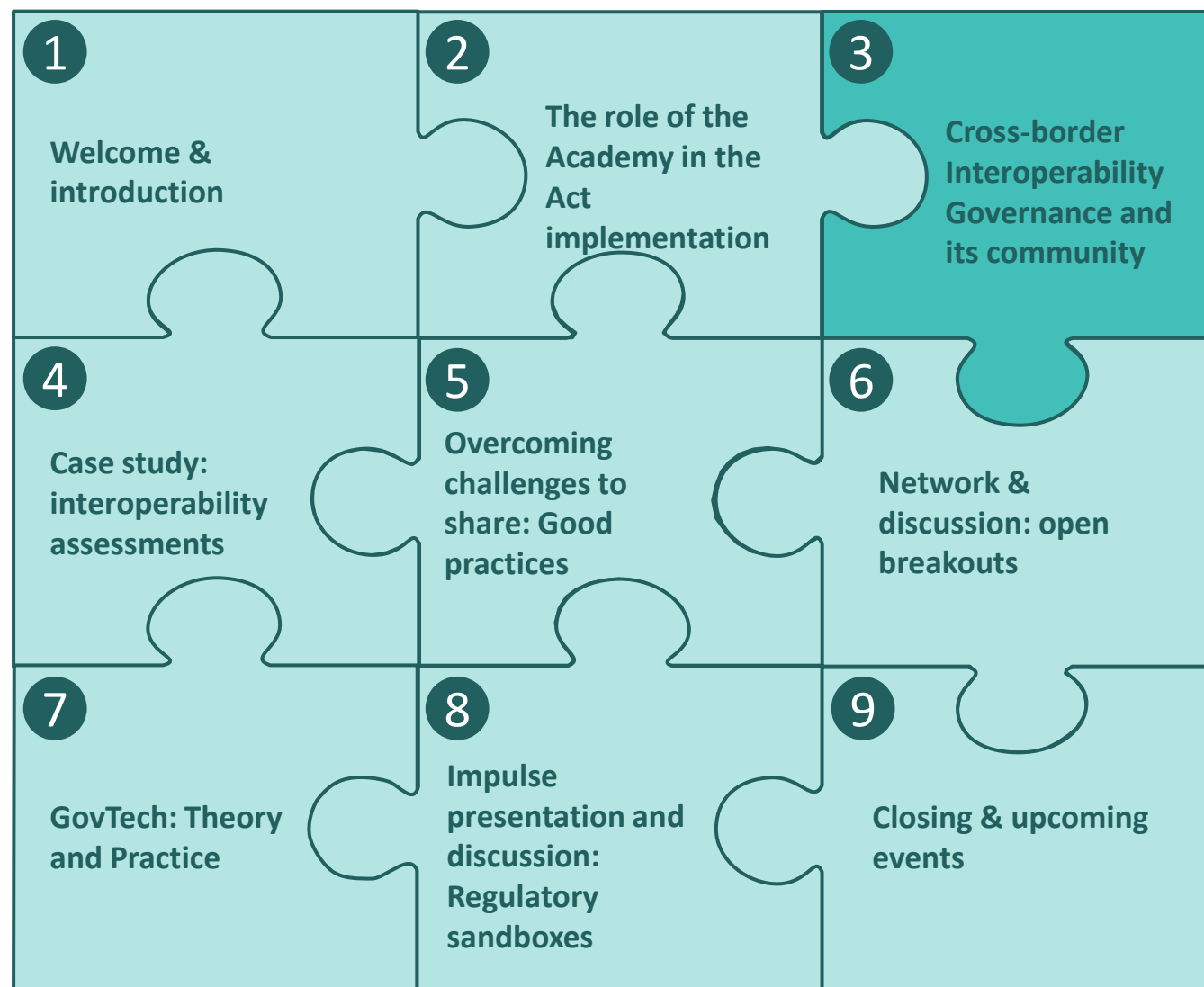

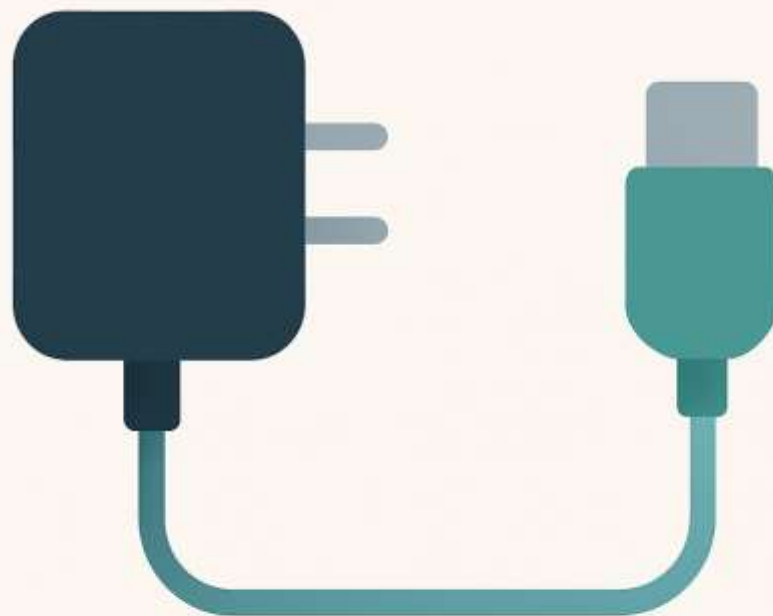

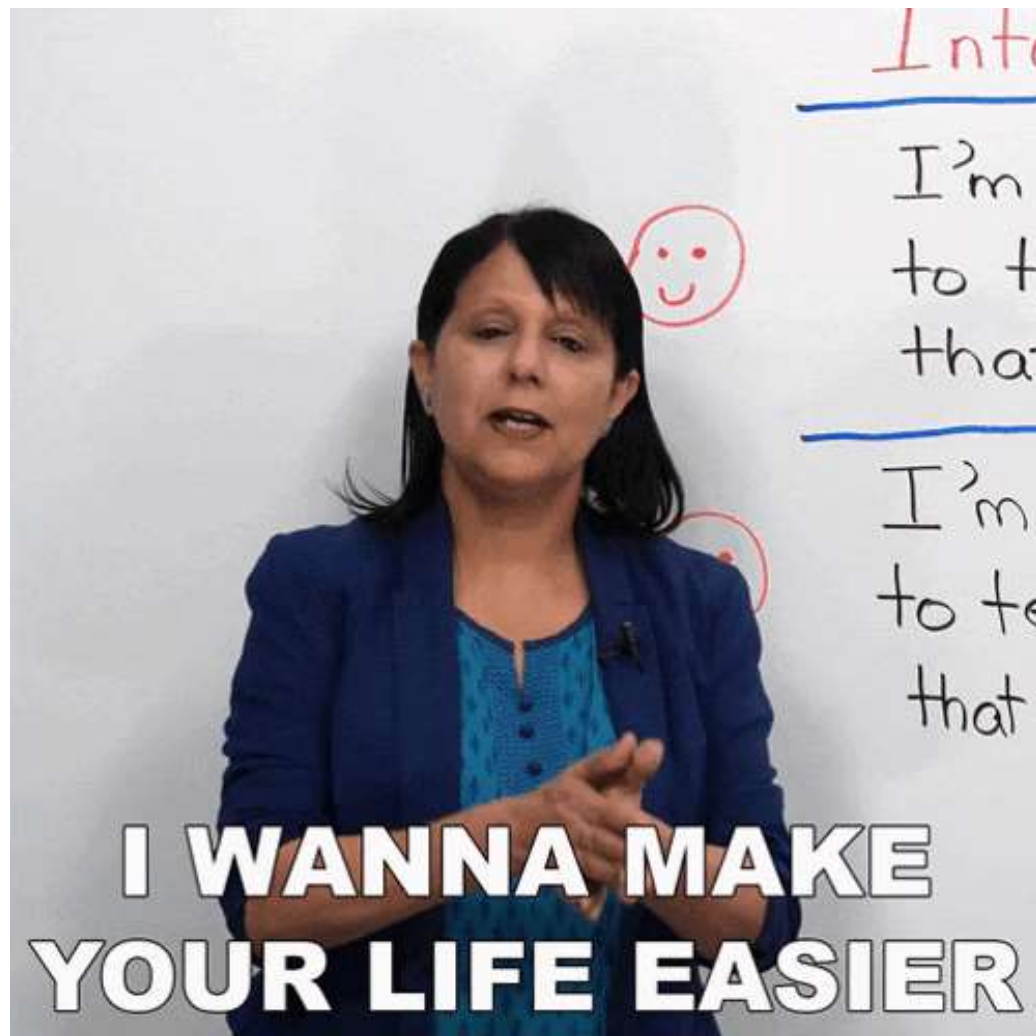

The Interoperable Europe Act in a nutshell

To help EU and Member State administrations to deliver connected digital services to citizens and businesses across Europe

Digital public services and their systems

All services requiring interaction across Member States' borders by means of their network and information systems

What?

Union entities and public sector bodies

All entities that provide or manage digital public services

Who?

Why?

Better public services

By making people think about interoperability before they make decisions having impact on it

When?

Entry into force expected in April 2024

Application after 3 months, except for Article 3 and 17 where application is after 9 months

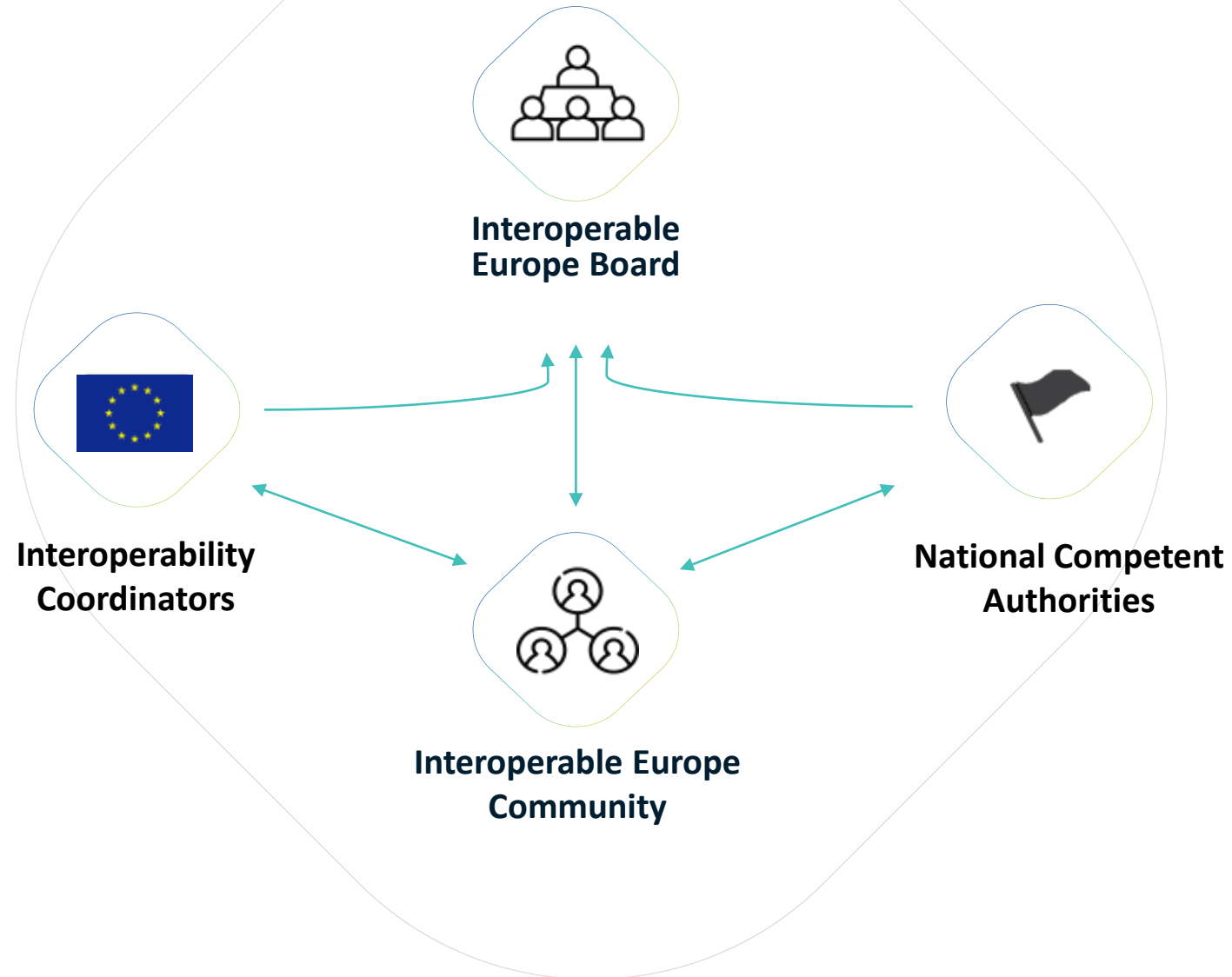

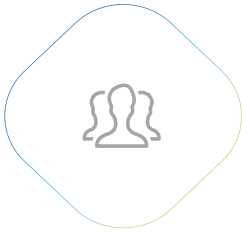

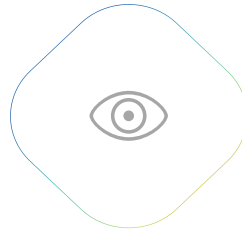
Governance – Interoperable Europe Board (Article 15)

The Interoperable Europe Board – a new governance structure to foster strategic cooperation and provide guidance on the Act's application.



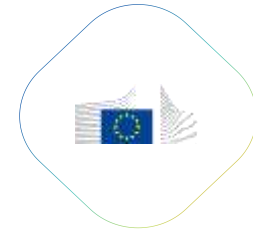
Membership

The Board consists of one representative from each Member State and the European Commission, ensuring a comprehensive representation of EU interests and perspectives.



Observers

Experts designated by the Committee of the Regions, the EU Cybersecurity Agency (ENISA), and the European Cybersecurity Competence Centre (ECCC) are invited to participate as observers.



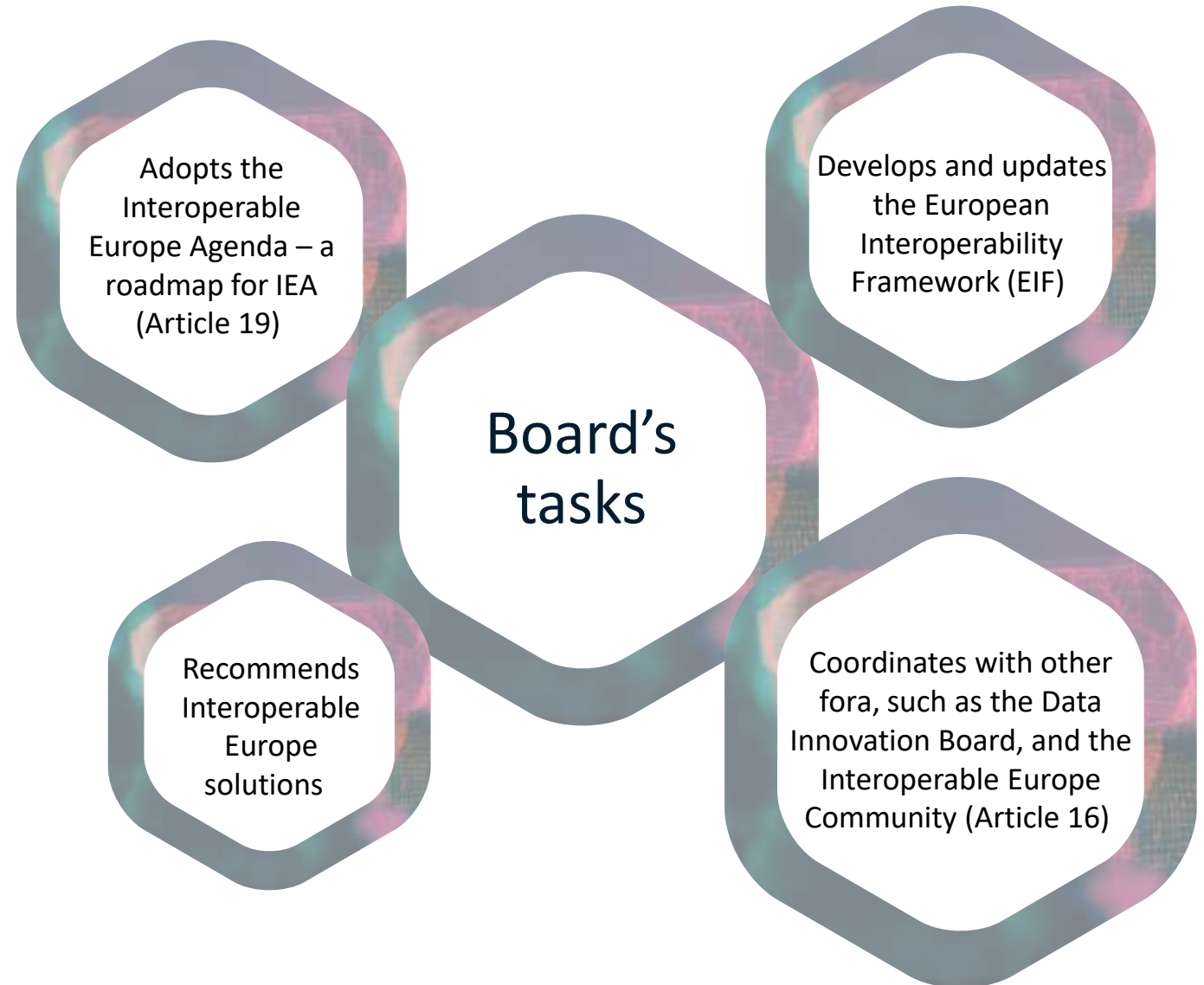
Chair

The Board is chaired by the Commission.

Interoperable Europe Community (Article 16)

The Interoperable Europe Community, launched under the Interoperable Europe Act, is providing a **common space** for public and private stakeholders, including experts, practitioners, researchers, and citizens, to co-create, exchange knowledge, and contribute to the practical implementation of interoperability across the EU driven by real-world experience and collective expertise.

The Community also supports the Interoperable Europe Board by providing input to guide its strategic decisions on cross-border digital public services.

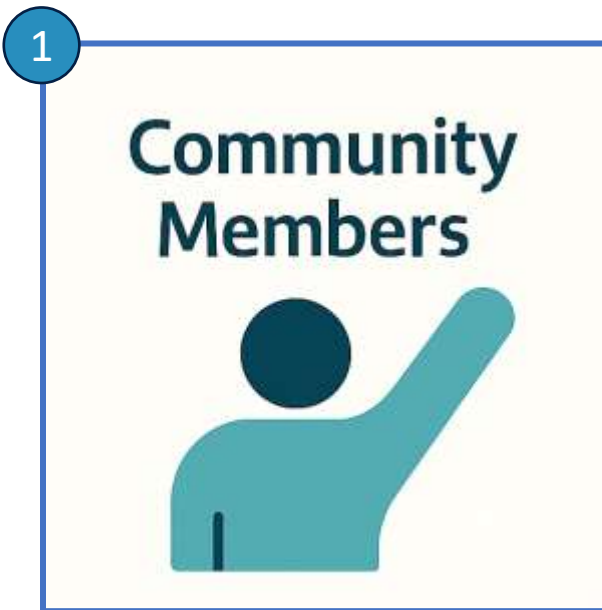
