




Next phases

- Relations: (march/april)
 - release of "relations" functionality to let users connect contents between eachother.
 - release of "organisation" presented close to user name.
- Workflows: (may/june)
 - release of basic "workflow" approach:
 Editors may decide to give more importance to some of their comments to communicate about a current status. Once an idea is considered for action, commenting may be closed by editors as a result that only editors may continue to post comments that are used, in that case, to communicate about current status (action taken, implementation...)
