## 2. SUMMARY

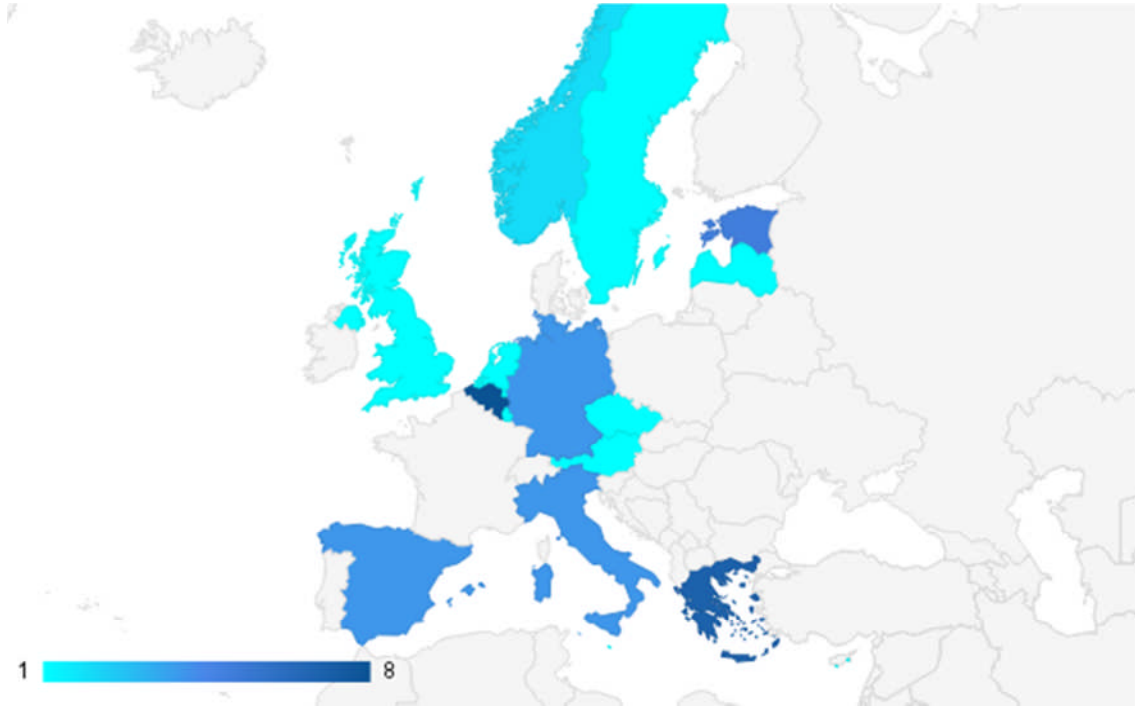
The audience of the webinar included participants from different national public administrations, multiple DGs of the European Commission, academic institutions and private sector. The full list of participants can be found in the table below.

After the speakers delivered the presentations in accordance to the agenda, there was a follow-up discussion via telephone and chat. The discussion and feedback received during the webinar can be summarized as follows:

- Several participants have expressed their interest in secure document exchange, especially in digital stamps, electronic signatures, and long term preservation of integrity and authenticity of electronic documents.
- There was an interest in building a framework for “European” e-Document formats, which would be used by public administrations across the Member States. Both ISA and e-SENS have solutions for some aspects to offer, but many open questions remain with regard to a common e-Document format.
- Some participants showed their interest in the future work concerning additional ISA Core Vocabularies and their usage in building e-Documents.
