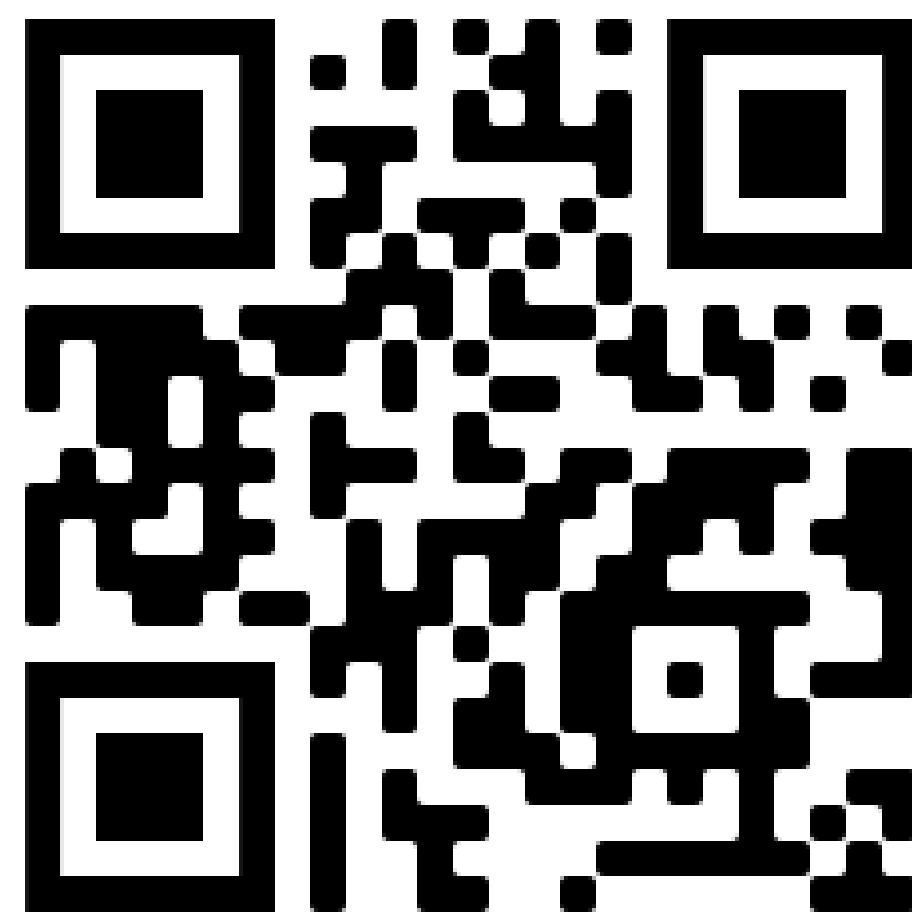

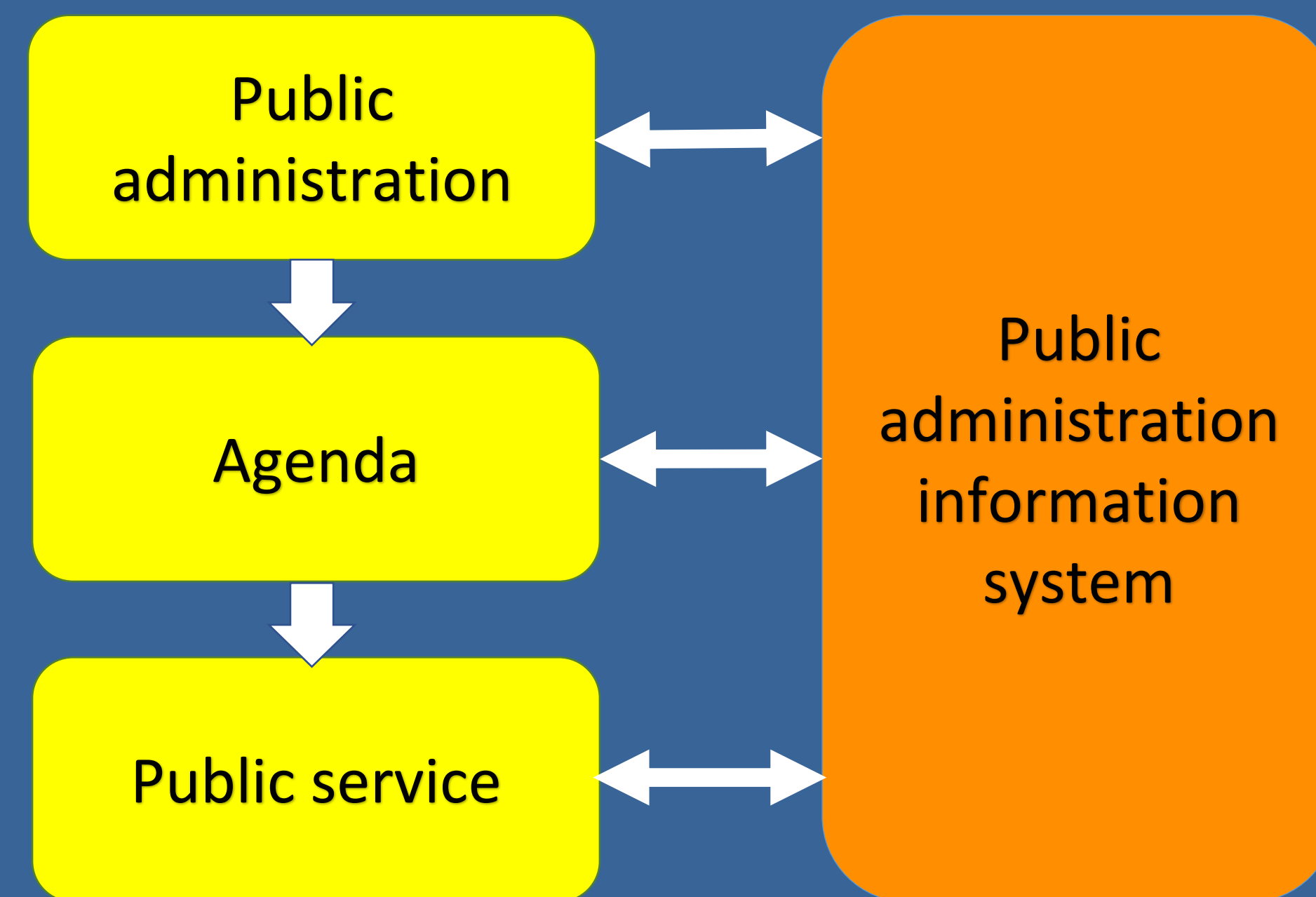

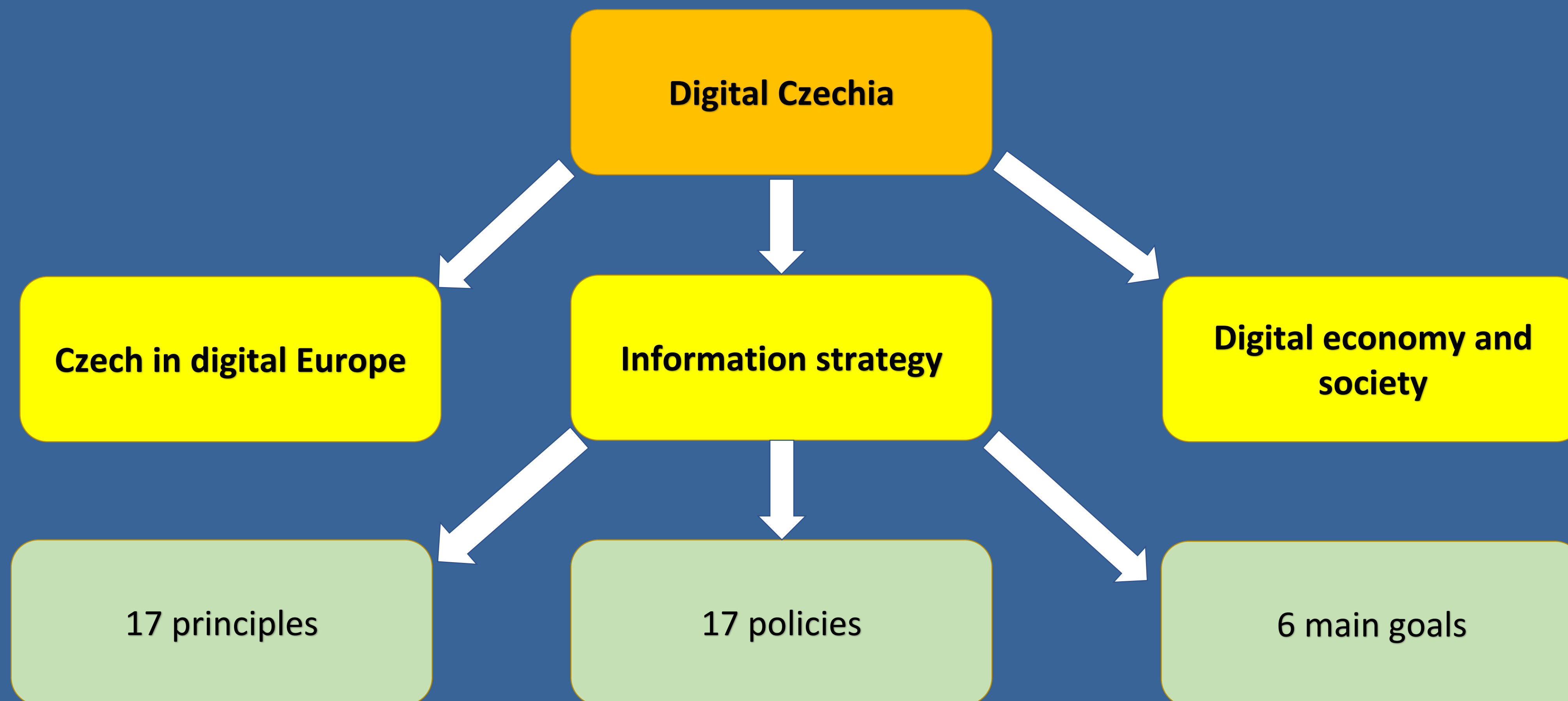

# Czech eGovernment

- 4 base registries
- 2 exchange information systems
- Almost 7 000 public administrations
- More than 6 000 public administration information systems  
(3 000 connected to base registries)
- Over 400 agendas
- Over 6 000 public services

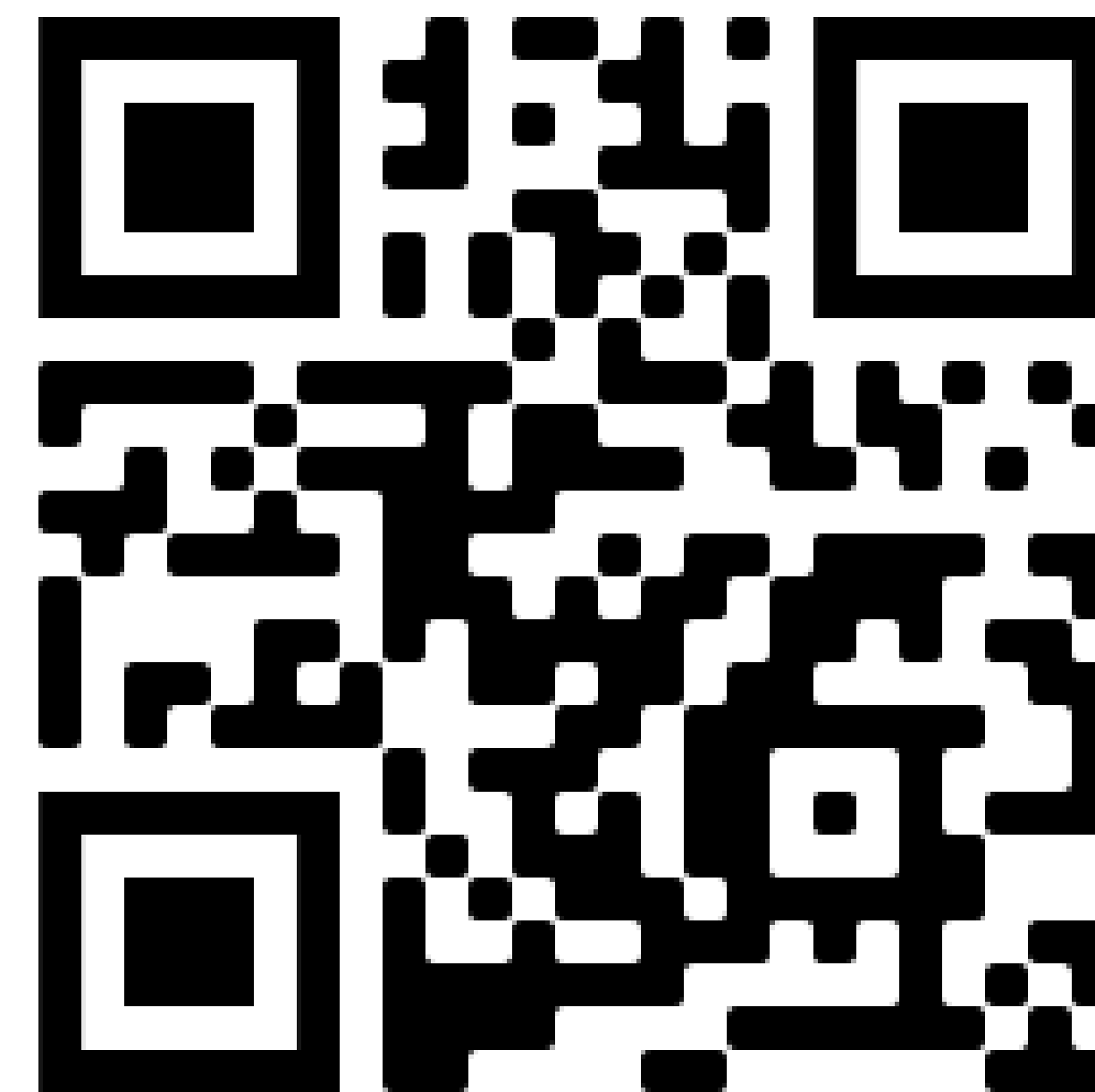

# Information strategy

- The Information Strategy of the Czech Republic is a document obligatory from the Act 365/2000 Coll.
- It contains generally formulated principles, goals and objectives which must be fulfilled by ICT project of public administration.
- Information strategy is followed by more specific parts, all described at <https://archi.gov.cz>:
  - **Glossary of eGovernment terms,**
  - **National Architecture Plan,**
  - **Methods of public administration ICT management,**
  - **National Architecture Framework.**

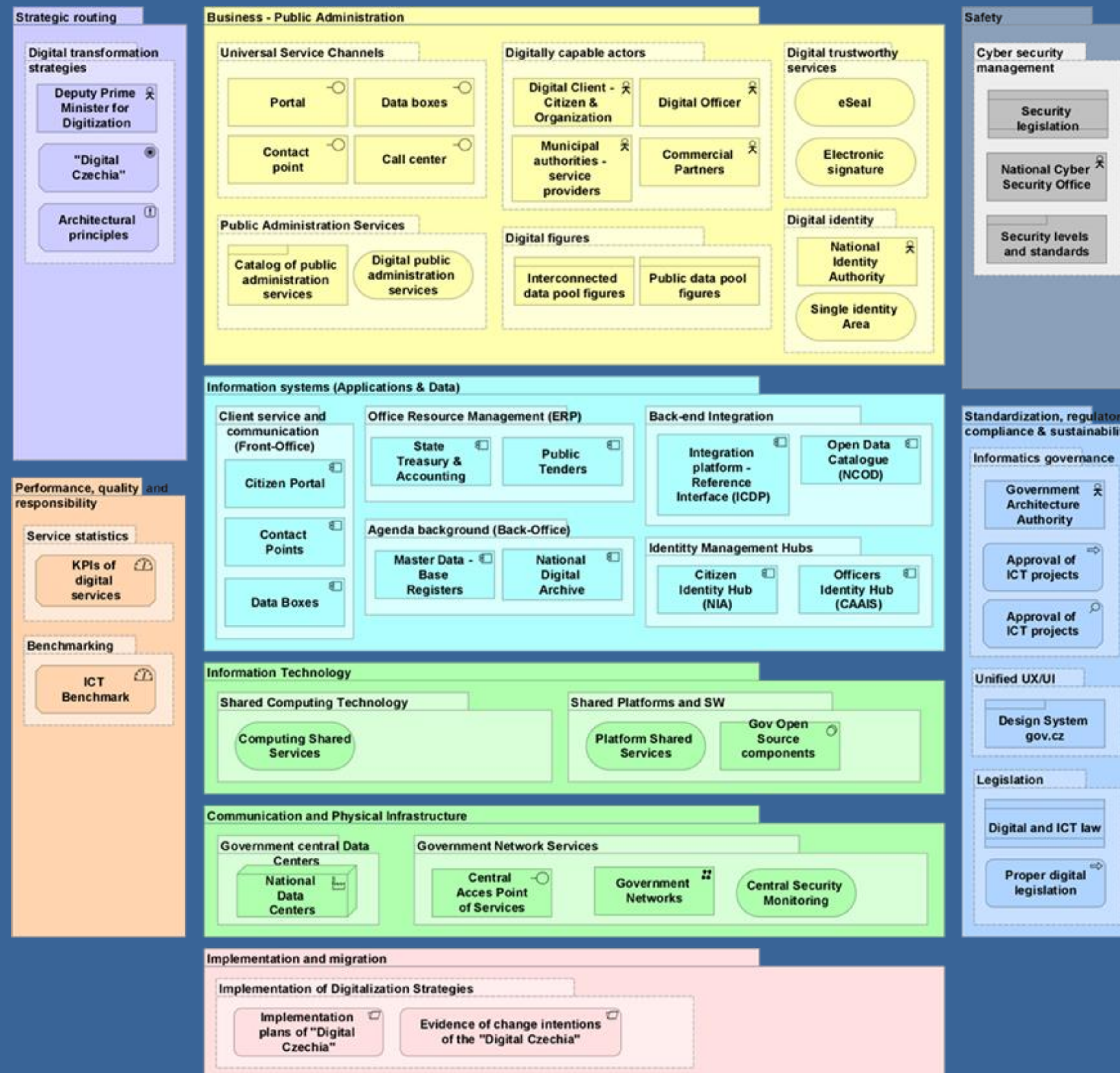
# National eGovernment Architecture



- The National eGovernment Architecture is **a collection of all rules and services**, both central and local, which is published and managed at **<https://archi.gov.cz>**,
- Compliance with the obligations of the public administration from the **National eGovernment Architecture** is controlled by the **Ministry of the Interior** when approving expenditure on ICT projects for "Designated Information Systems" according to Act No. 365/2000 Coll. and also according to Government Resolution No. 86/2020.
- **Department of Chief eGovernment architect** is responsible for maintaining National eGovernment Architecture

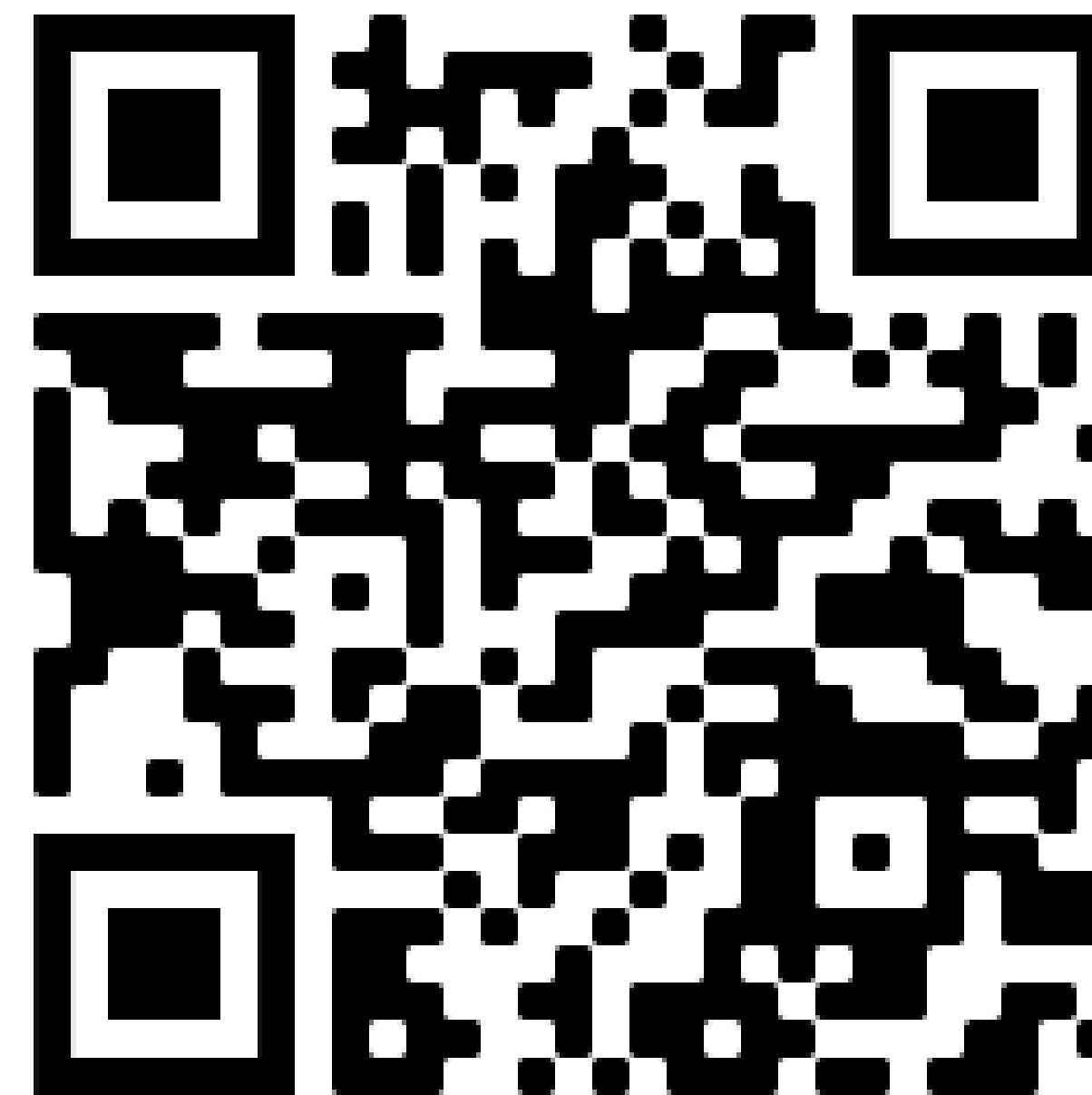






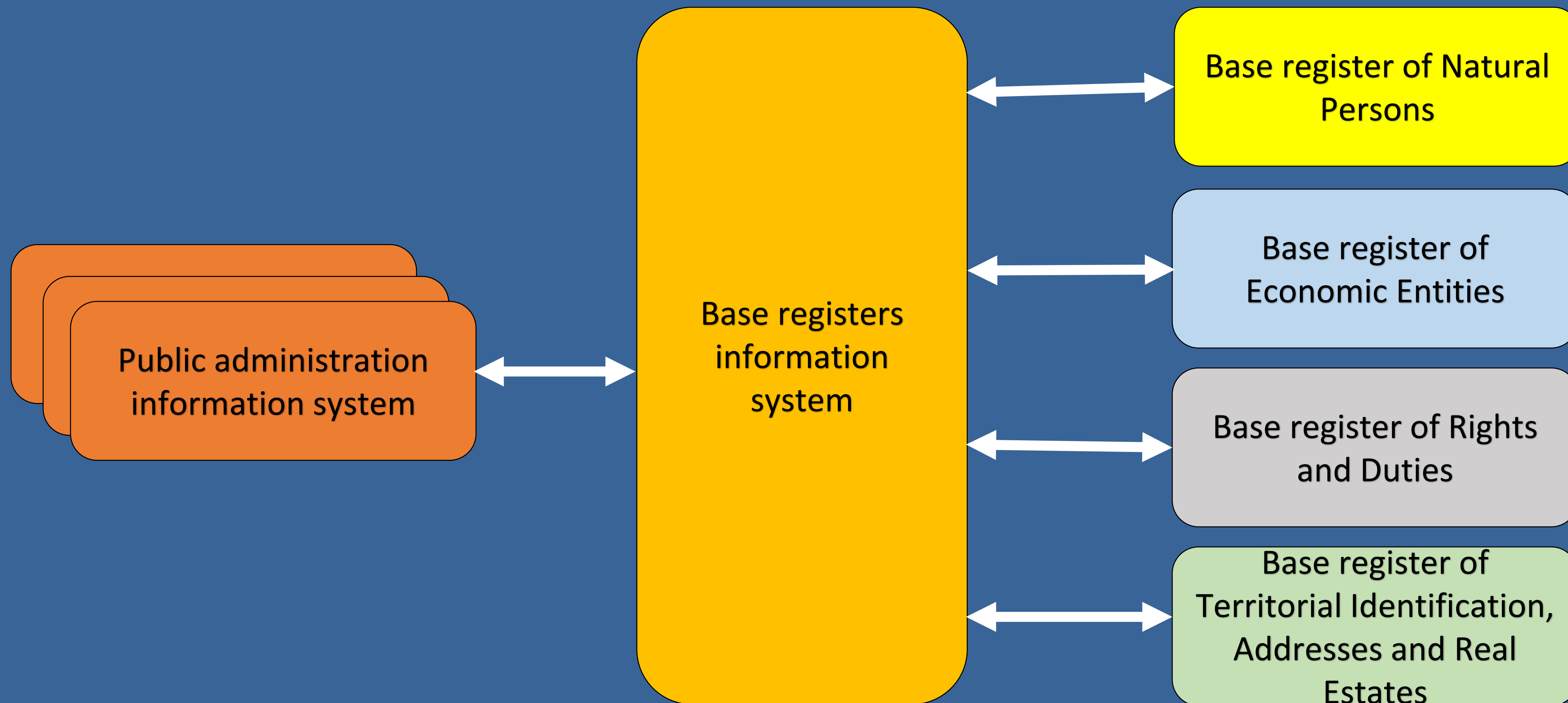
