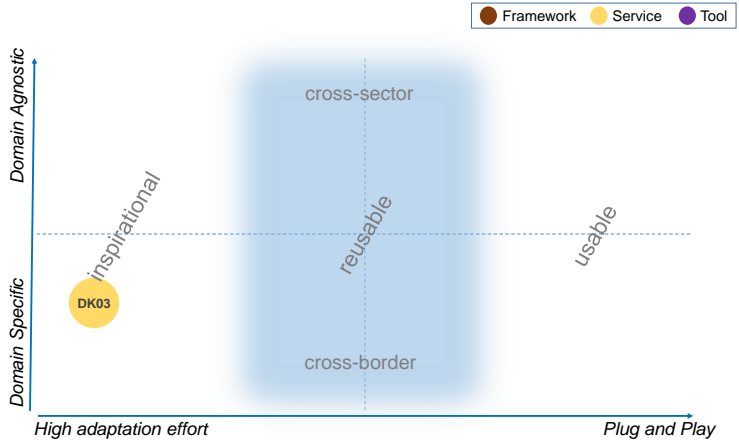
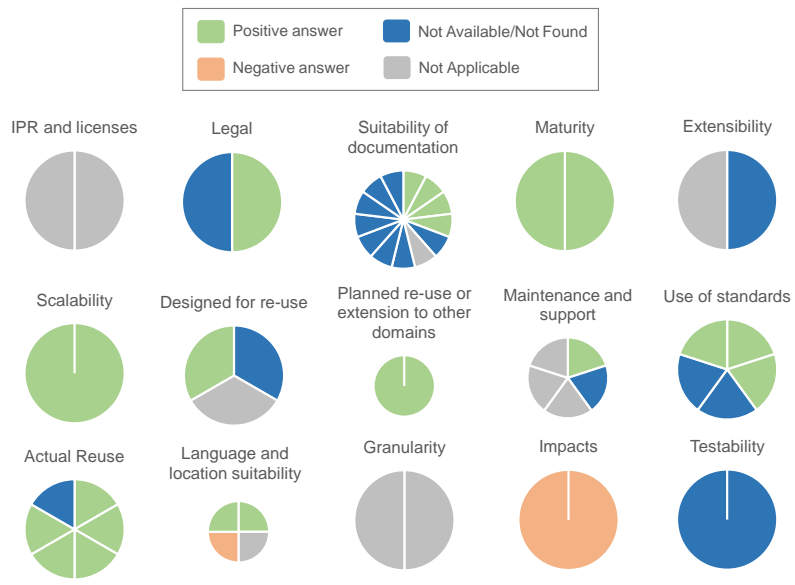

Short description	The Data Distributor will be the common authoritative distribution point for Basic Data in Denmark, making easier and cheaper to publish and use authoritative Basic Data.

Functionalities	Web services for accessing Basic Data File downloads of Basic Data Distribution of event notifications (for EDA) regarding Basic Data.

Technologies	Microsoft technologies – Windows server and .Net are supplemented by FOSS such as GeoServer and MySQL.
Specifications	The solutions relies on numerous technical standards and specifications such as: ISO/IEC 27001 INSPIRE OGC standards (WMS, WFS, WMTS etc.)

Governance	The Danish Geodata Agency is the responsible authority for implementing and operating the solution. Each Basic Data Registry is responsible for their own data and services as well as user rights administration.
