Highlights

Political Communications

In November 2021, the French Government adopted its [Action Plan on Free Software and Digital Commons](#). Through this Action Plan, free and open source software were described as one of the main levers for the digital transformation of administrations.

Legislation

In November 2021, France adopted [a law on the reduction of the environmental footprint of the digital sector](#). The law aims to bring together the digital and ecological transitions.

Governance

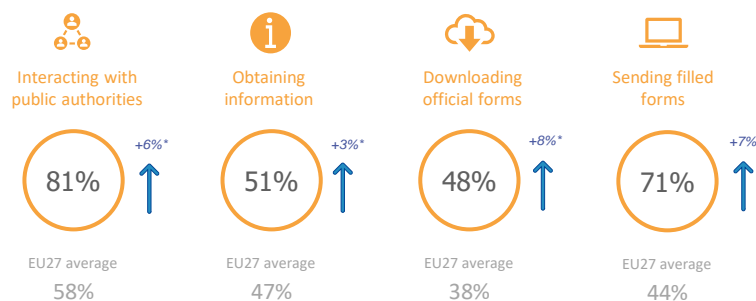
In 2021, the [Digital Transformation of Territories \(TNT\) programme](#) replaced the former Concerted Development of Territorial Digital Transformation (DCANT) program, which ended in 2020. TNT is a cooperation program between the central government and local authorities to address the challenges of digital transformation of local authorities.

Infrastructure

In 2021, France notified its first substantial level eIDAS scheme. In 2022, the French eIDAS node should open up to interoperable eIDAS nodes of other European countries.

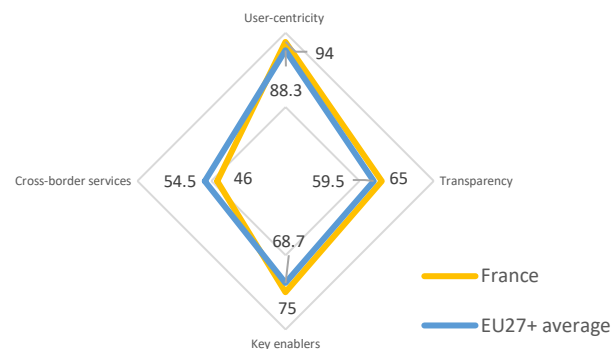
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

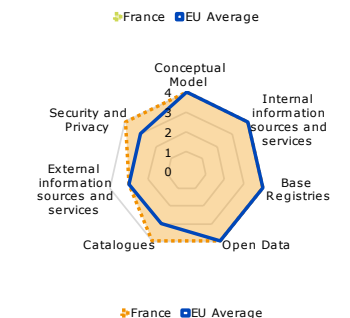
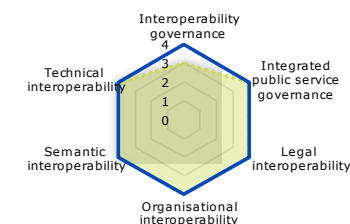
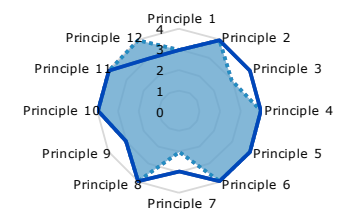
eGovernment indicators
