Political Communications

The draft of the [National Digitalisation Strategy 2021-2030](#) was completed in June 2020 and addresses four main priority areas: Digital infrastructure, Digital skills, Digital economy and Digital State.

Legislation

Based on [Government Decree 1422/2020](#), the launch of the PetaFlops national supercomputer (HPC) services is planned for 2022, serving both academic and industrial communities, including SMEs.

Governance

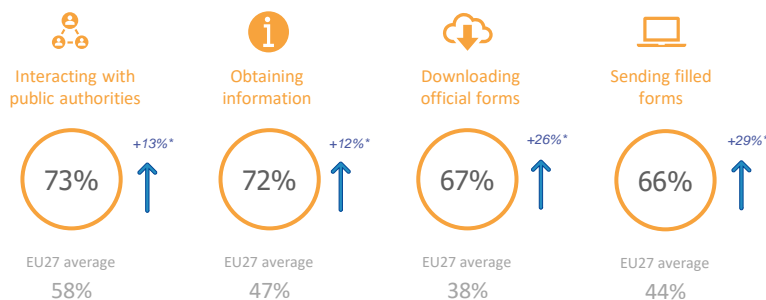
In 2020, the Governmental Information Technology Development Agency (KIFU) has also established the national HPC Competence Centre (CC), which has joined the network of the EuroHPC Competence Centres on 1 September 2020.

Infrastructure

According to the [eAdministration Act](#), all public administration bodies providing eGovernment services are obliged to publish their services on the Portal. As of January 2022, there were 3027 public services published on the portal.

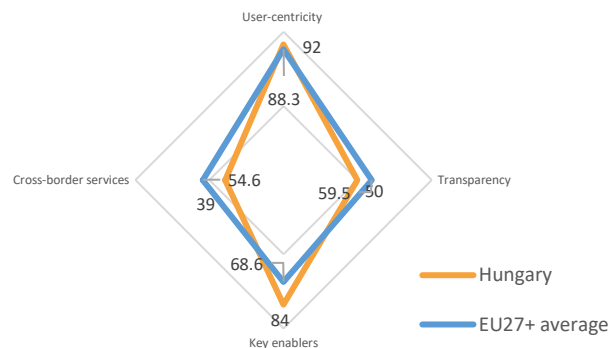
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

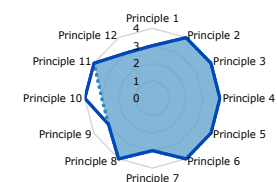
eGovernment indicators

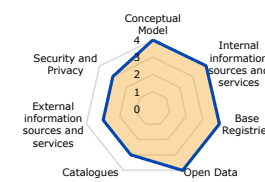
State-of-Play of Interoperability
