## **Political Communications**

In December 2021, the Maltese Ministry for Justice and Governance launched its new <u>Digital Justice Strategy</u> for the years 2022-2027, which seeks to adopt a strategic framework to make further use of the available technologies, respect the rule of law and the substantive and procedural rights of all citizens.

## Legislation

In June 2021, the <u>Regulation (EU) 2021/887</u> came into force, establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination Centres.

## Governance

Business First, a joint venture between Malta Enterprise and the Malta Chamber of SMEs, is currently working on creating a Business Portal which, when implemented, will contribute towards the national strategy in transforming Malta into a digitally enabled economy across all sectors of society.

## Infrastructure

A Legal Notice is currently in the process of being established for the implementation of a Person Register which shall provide measures to facilitate the sharing and re-use of personal data between public sector bodies.




