Political Communications

The Federal Department of Environment, Transport, Energy and Communications (DETEC) drew up a concept and an action plan to support the towns and the cities, the municipalities and the cantons in the development of Smart Cities, Smart Villages and Smart Regions.

Legislation

The Confederation and the cantons approved the <u>public-law framework agreement on Digital Public Services Switzerland</u> in September 2021, so as to ensure a strategic coordination of federal, cantonal and communal digitalization activities.

Governance

The <u>Digital Public Services Switzerland Office</u> supports the Digital Public Services Officer for the Confederation and Cantons. The operational tasks of the Swiss Informatics Conference (SIK) and eGovernment Switzerland are continued by the DPSS office.

Infrastructure

The <u>Data Science Competence Centre</u> (DSCC) is a service provider within the federal administration and as such, provides data science services and expertise to the entire Swiss public sector and administration (Confederation, cantons and communes).






Percentage of individuals using the internet for





eGovernment performance across policy priorities




State-of-Play of Interoperability
