


Political Communications

The Finish government launched the <u>AuroraAl national</u> <u>artificial intelligence programme</u> on 6 February 2020, with the aim of creating a service model where, by using artificial intelligence, public services are arranged so that they support people in their life-events and organisations in their business.

Governance

The responsibility for Finland's eGovernment strategy/policy lies within the <u>Ministry of Finance</u>, which is also the body responsible for interoperability activities.

Legislation


The <u>Act on Information Management in Public Administration</u> (906/2019) entered into force on 1 January 2020, defining the entire lifecycle of information in Finnish public administration.

Infrastructure

A key development in 2020 is the launch of the next version of the <u>X-Road data exchange between Finland and Estonia</u>. X-Road technology provides the main data exchange solution for Finnish public sector organisations. It is managed by the <u>Nordic Institute for Interoperability Solutions (NIIS)</u>.
