<b>Management</b>	<p>The Common Directory establishes the following entities of information, where management is indispensable for the suitable functioning of the applications of record:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Organic unit</b> (basic functional structure of the administrative organs) is understood by Organic Unit (or Organism, in administrative slang), any administrative unit that realizes an exercise of functions with juridical transcendancy. For example, the General Secretariat of Public Administration.</li> <li>- <b>Office</b> (of record and attention to the citizen) understands for Office, in the frame of the Common Directory, any Office of record, information or processing that the different Public Administrations put at the disposal of the Citizen. For example, the Office of General Record of the Community of Madrid.</li> </ul>
