In August 2022, the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) published its <u>new</u> <u>Federal Digital Strategy</u> . The strategy defines three key projects, which are the prerequisite for boosting digital transformation: (1) Network rollout and improving standardised provision of data; (2) Providing digital identities, not only for the use of public administration services; and (3) Creating uniform framework conditions and standards to allow the highest degree of interoperability. In addition, the first <u>Startup Strategy</u> of the Federal Government was adopted in 2022 with the aim to improve the start-up ecosystem and	No recent legislations have been reported to date.	In 2022, the <u>German Metadata Portal GovData</u> was opened for metadata by companies in general services, universities, researchers, research institutions and research funding institutions. Regarding connectivity, the first version of the <u>Gigabit-Register</u> went online in December 2022 with updated data for fixed- and mobile- network expansion in the German Broadband Atlas. In 2023, the Gigabit-Register will be further developed in close cooperation with the users of the services.	No recent changes on governance have been reported to date.
