Governance

With the resolution of the new Federal Ministries Act in 2020, the Austrian Federal Computing Centre (Bundesrechenzentrum — BRZ) was incorporated into the Federal Ministry for Digital and Economic Affairs.

Legislation


On 1 January 2020, the right to electronically interact with the public administration entered into force (eGovernment-Act).

Austria has defined as priorities for 2021 the following topics: mobile government (including the start of an ID platform), the implementation of the once-only principle across infrastructures and cloud computing.




eGovernment performance across policy priorities
