Highlights

Political Communications

In January 2020 was approved the <u>National Artificial</u> <u>Intelligence strategy</u> which aims at improving the quality of public services through the use of digital and Al-related applications, among others.

Governance

No recent changes in governance have been reported to date.

Legislation

In April 2021, the Cypriot Parliament amended the Population Register law and of the Department of Electronic Communications law, with the aim of adopting the National eID Scheme.

Infrastructure

The Deputy Ministry for Research, Innovation and Digital Policy adopted the "as-a-Service aaS" model (Infrastructure as a Service, Platform as a Service, Software as a Service) across the government.



eGovernment indicators


eGovernment performance across policy priorities






