# Highlights

#### **Political Communications**

In late 2020, the French government launched the 'France Relance' recovery plan, under which EUR 1 billion will be dedicated to the State and local authorities' digital transformation over the 2020-2022 period to fund digital transformation initiatives.

### Governance

In July 2020, the French government created a Ministry for Public Transformation and Civil Service responsible for the State's transformation policy and notably the promotion of actions to accelerate the State's digital transformation.

# Legislation


The <u>Law for a State at the Service of a Society based on Trust</u> was promulgated in August 2018, establishing the principle of the right to error (in French *droit à l'erreur*) and including a series of measures to simplify administrative formalities.

#### Infrastructure

The <u>Digital Identity Mission</u>, conducted under the <u>Tech.gouv programme</u>, made considerable progress in 2020, notably with the continuous uptake of FranceConnect, France's eID system, which counted over 21 million users in January 2021.


### eGovernment indicators
