

Highlights

Political Communications

In late 2020, the French government launched the 'France Relance' recovery plan, under which EUR 1 billion will be dedicated to the State and local authorities' digital transformation over the 2020-2022 period to fund digital transformation initiatives.

Legislation

The Law for a State at the Service of a Society based on Trust was promulgated in August 2018, establishing the principle of the right to error (in French *droit à l'erreur*) and including a series of measures to simplify administrative formalities.

Governance

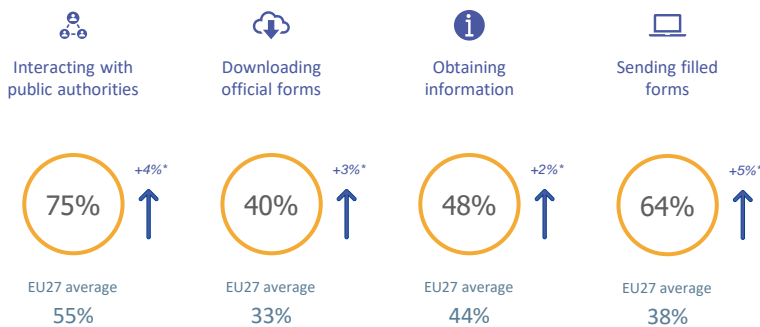
In July 2020, the French government created a Ministry for Public Transformation and Civil Service responsible for the State's transformation policy and notably the promotion of actions to accelerate the State's digital transformation.

Infrastructure

The Digital Identity Mission, conducted under the Tech.gouv programme, made considerable progress in 2020, notably with the continuous uptake of FranceConnect, France's eID system, which counted over 21 million users in January 2021.

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

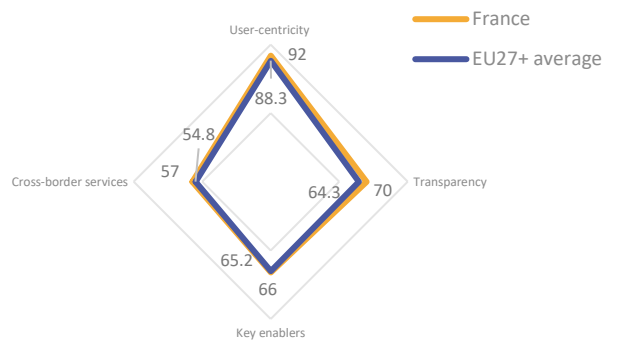

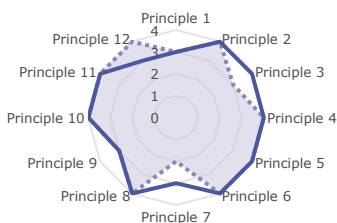
eGovernment performance across policy priorities

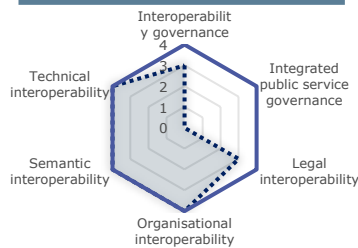

SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES



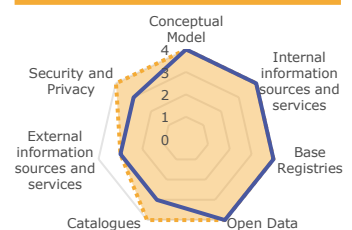
