Governance

Legislation


Many pieces of existing legislation apply to digital public administration. Some specific legislation includes the Data Sharing and Governance Act 2019, the Single Digital Gateway Regulation, the eIDAS Regulation and ePrivacy Regulations.

Infrastructure

In 2020, Ireland continued to implement and expand gov.ie, a central portal for online government services. Activity on gov.ie has increased substantially over the past year or so, with numbers of visitors increasing from 6 million in 2019 to over 97 million in 2020.




eGovernment performance across policy priorities


