Governance

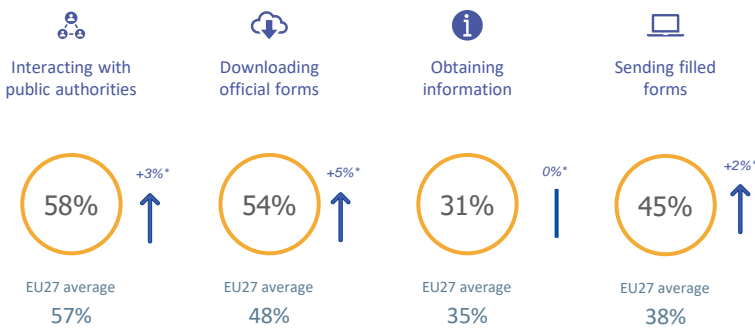
In 2020 the project [GovTech Lab](#) won the best Lithuanian public sector project award established by the Project Management Institute.

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

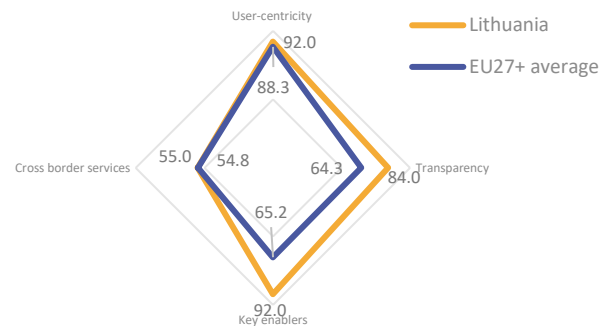

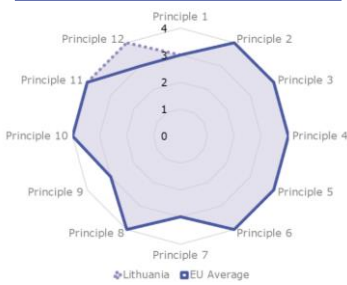
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



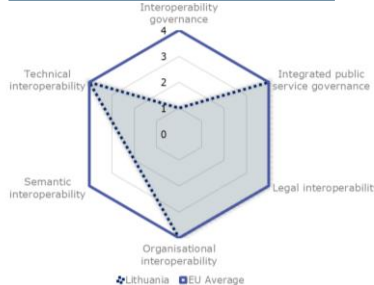

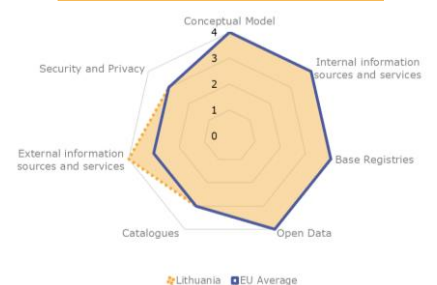
SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES
