Legislation

On 1 January 2021, the new Public Procurement Law came into force, which envisages that all public procurement procedures, regardless of their value, will be electronic.

Governance

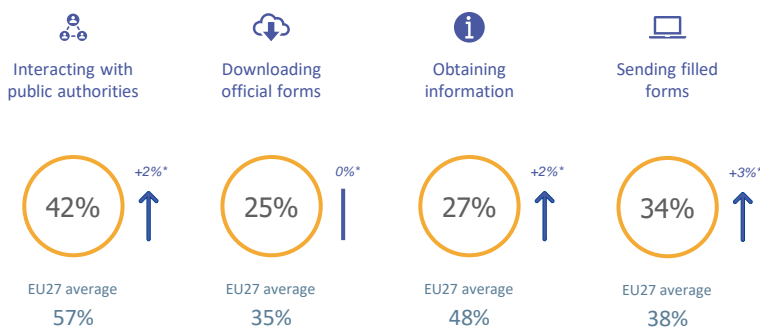

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

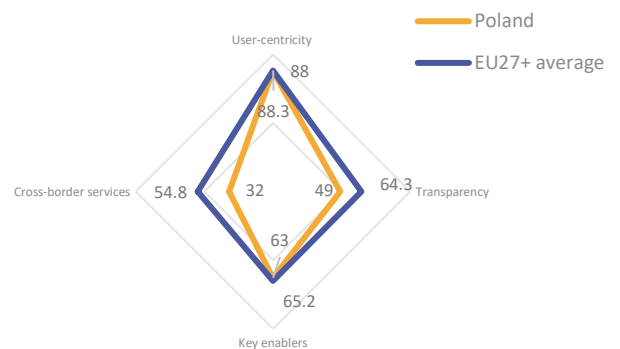

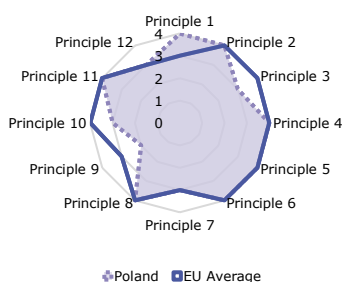
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



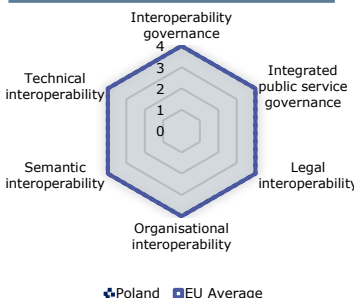

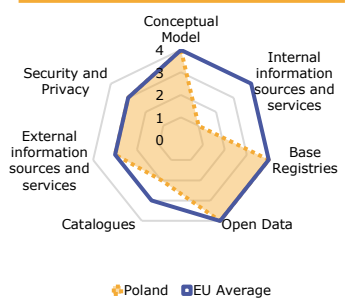
SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES
