As of 1 May 2019, a new [Act No. 95/2019](#) on Information Technologies in Public Sector entered into force. The new Act brought a systemic change in the management of IT in the public sector.

Governance

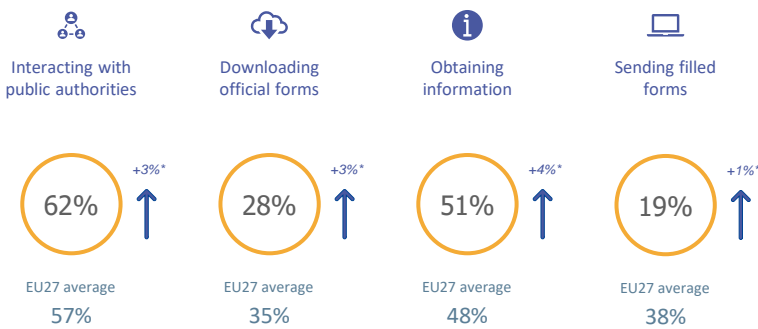

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

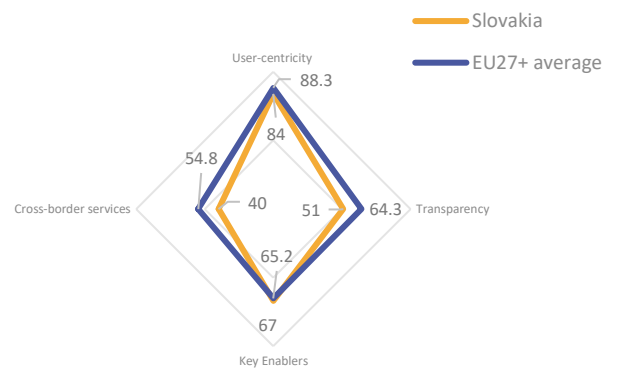

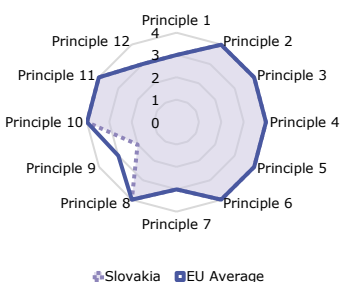
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



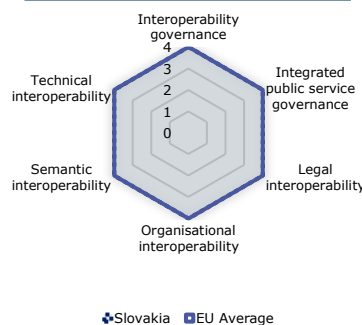

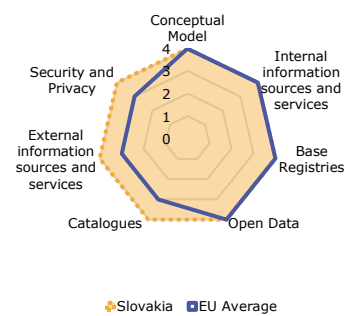
SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES
