A new strategy, called <u>Digital Slovenia 2030</u>, should be adopted by the end of 2021 and will succeed the Digital Slovenia 2020 on subjects such as Digital inclusion, Digital public services, ICT infrastructure, Society 5.0. and Cybersecurity.

Governance

Slovenia established in April 2021 a <u>Strategic Council</u> <u>for Digitalisation</u>, as an advisory body to the Prime Minister, complementary to the Council for Informatics Development in Public Administration and together they will form strong strategic framework for the digitalisation.
