On 11 September 2020, the Federal Council adopted its [Digital Switzerland Strategy](#) for the following two years (2020-2022), which is the federal government's overarching strategy on digital policy.

Legislation

On 11 December 2020, the Federal Council brought into force, with effect from 1 February 2021, the parts of the DLT bill that enable ledger-based securities to be introduced.

Governance

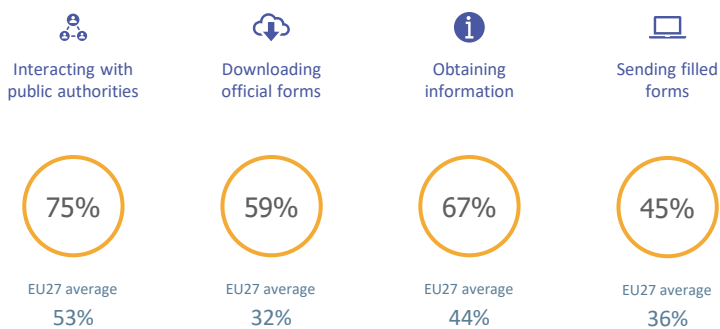
In January 2021, [the Digital Transformation and ICT Steering](#) took over the tasks of the former Federal IT Steering Unit, the Digital Switzerland unit at the Federal Office of Communications, and the GEVER Bund unit at the Federal Chancellery.

Infrastructure

As of 1 January 2021, there are two options for settling VAT online: the [ESTV SuisseTax Portal](#) and the '[VAT invoicing easy](#)' service. In accordance with the eGovernment Strategy, they will replace paper-based accounting.

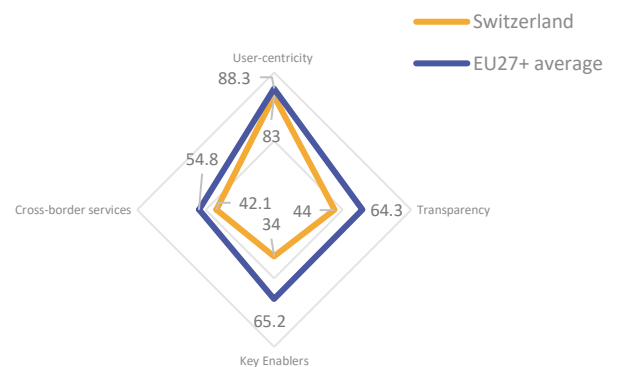
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

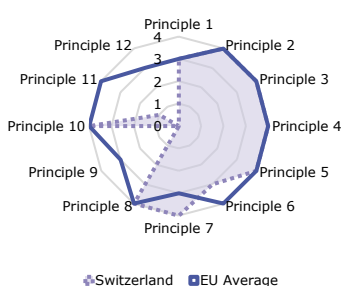
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



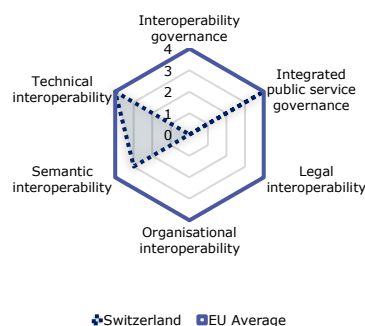

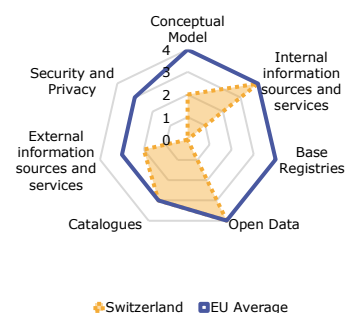
SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES
