The National Cybersecurity Strategy and Action Plan for the period 2020-2023 was put into force in 2020. In line with the Turkish 2023 goals, this action plan will determine the goals, strategies and actions of the upcoming period in the cybersecurity area.

Governance

In October 2019, the eGovernment tasks were transferred to the <u>Digital Transformation Office</u> which now coordinates all activities related to eGovernment, digital public administration, cybersecurity, critical infrastructures, big data and Al.

Legislation


A new regulation on e-seal was made in the <u>Electronic Signature Law No.5070</u> in January 2021. With the e-seal, this regulation aims to make legal person's transactions in the electronic environment more secure.




eGovernment performance across policy priorities
