Initiative	Criteria for selecting data sources as a base registry	
Short description	<p>The basic records relate to the actions of the government main subjects, objects and the relationships between them. Together they form the scheme of base registries, consisting of authentic information about people, companies, addresses, places and their location (land and topography), vehicles, wages, employment and benefits ratios, earnings, surface, and the value of real estate.</p> <p>The Netherlands currently has 12 base registers that are part of the “Stelsel van Basisregistraties”, a scheme of base registers.</p> <p>The scheme of base registers is "the set of agreements and provisions aimed at effective and efficient management of limited data that are necessary for the implementation of the tasks of the government, enshrined in data sets with a legal basis (basic registration) including their interdependence and common facilities required for collection, dissemination and use."</p> <p>The scheme of base registers can be expanded with registers that meet “12 criteria/principles”, and if the added value is considered for the administrations. The added value of the scheme lies not only in the data sets (basic records) itself, but also in their interrelationships, relationships, couplings and arrangements at the level of the scheme as a whole.</p>

Sustainability	<p>Building on the Vision of the Base Registers Scheme, published in 2010, in 2014, the Programme of Basic Registrations System (PSB) established the 'Vision of the Scheme of Government Information. This Vision is an appealing prospect for the development of the Scheme of Base Registers and positions the scheme again, now with respect to sectoral information. This was necessary because the implementation of the scheme has shown that government-wide reuse of data requires a government-wide distribution of responsibilities and government-wide coordination and direction in which, because of the limited feasibility of the government, assumed to be of organic development of this system of government data.</p> <p>The realization of the 'Vision on the System of Government Information including an elaboration of the rotunda contained therein, is one of the priorities of the Regieraad Data described in the Digiprogramme in 2015, launched by the Digicommissaris.</p>
