Short description	<p>The central meta Information System of public administration (MetaIS) is aimed at monitoring e-services across all levels of government. While its pilot-test was initiated in 2011, MetaIS became operational later in 2016. MetaIS is currently being implemented and gathers information about national e-government services, municipal services, application services, public information systems and code lists. This information is presented in a user-friendly way so that both civil servants and citizens can easily access it. As such, MetaIS fosters, on the one hand, the use of national digital public services and, on the other hand, transparency towards public administration e-government data and services.</p> <p>MetaIS is structured into the following sections:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Monitoring</b> project and services metrics;</li><li>- <b>Life situations</b>: view of citizen on business processes;</li><li>- <b>URI</b>: list of reference identifiers;</li><li>- <b>Projects</b>: including feasibility studies and development concepts;</li><li>- <b>Enterprise architecture</b>: architectures of public administration;</li><li>- <b>Data elements</b> catalogue;</li><li>- State <b>software licenses</b> Oracle and Microsoft;</li><li>- <b>Standardisation documents</b>: standards for information system of public administration;</li><li>- List of <b>reference registers</b>.</li></ul> <p>On the other side, the Central Meta Information System of public administration serves as a catalogue of national base registries. It provides information regarding the inclusion of new registries into the catalogue, how to modify the information of the registry and information on the reference data administration.</p> <p>This system offers, among others, a substantial amount of up-to-date information and resources related to semantic interoperability. Some examples are: code lists, reference identifiers and definition of base registries and their data (through the catalogue of registries). Each entry includes basic information on the base registry such as the registry name, registry code, date of inclusion into the catalogue, registry responsible/administration and contact information, etc. Additionally, each entry keeps the identification of reference data held by the registry, including ontologies in OWL format.</p>
