


Joinup's transition to the Interoperable Europe Portal

The PM² Methodologies include PM² Project Management, PM²-Agile, PM² Programme Management, and PM² Portfolio Management.






PM² and Interoperable Europe Portal

Using EIRA© for interoperable digital public services



EIRA©. European Interoperability Reference Architecture.

A reference architecture is a blueprint/template that provides a **recommended framework** for designing and implementing systems. EIRA© provides **guidelines** on how to design and structure a **digital public service** so that is **interoperable by design**.

Unit of analysis of EIRA©

Focus of EIRA©

Content

EIRA© is formed by different Architecture Building Blocks (ABBs), informing key **requirements** and **capabilities** to consider to ensure interoperability, covering all interoperability **views defined in the EIF** (legal, organisational, semantic and technical).

Data standardisation and common format

Technical protocols and interface for data exchange

EIRA© provides a consistent way to document and classify reusable Solution Building Blocks (SBBs), allowing the **reusable and interoperable solutions to be found and understood more easily.**




Machine readable format

EIRA© adopts a service-oriented architecture style and **promotes ArchiMate® as a modelling machine readable notation.** Thus, enabling the conformance testing (iTestBed) as well as usage for public procurement.



Owners and Facilitators will be able to target announcements to specific members of their space, based on their professional domains.








Direct contact between the Portal's members

To enable easier communication, the new feature will allow Portal members to send direct messages to each other straight from the browser





Act related updates: Interoperability Assessments

The Act establishes that, depending on the scope, some public organisations are **legally required** to carry out interoperability assessments; others can do so in a **voluntary basis**.



The Interoperability Assessments' space in the Portal includes:

The Interoperable Europe Community space on the Portal will allow users to:













2. Users that are not blocked (active users)
