


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Improving user experience

- Turn on the notifications from the icon on the top right corner to keep up with all the messages.






Events calendar (for content creators)




- Content creators can now enhance their pages with the new events calendar feature.

Example: events calendar by week















Portal user reference guide & How-To articles

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Assessment Guidelines

In an era marked by rapid digital transformation, the <u>Interoperable Europe Act</u> emerges as a pivotal legislative document, guiding the **seamless delivery of digital public services across the European Union.** This act underscores the essentiality of interoperability - the ability of diverse organizations and systems to interact effectively, exchanging data and ensuring that public services are not only technologically advanced but also accessible and user-centric. In light of this, interoperability assessments become not just a technical necessity but also a strategic imperative.


Any interoperability assessment, as provided by Article 3 of the Interoperable Europe Act, aims to ensure that binding requirements for trans-European digital public services have adequately considered cross-border interoperability issues before being decided on.

Depending on the scope, public organisations are either **legally required** to carry out interoperability assessments, or, in other cases, a public organisation may carry out interoperability assessments on a **voluntary basis**.









Below you can either perform (through an online form) an interoperability assessment or upload the report of an already performed assessment.

You can also consult the user manual to get an idea of how to use this tool or to help you with its use.



Perform the assessment

Do you wish to start an interoperability assessment?


Click on the button below to start and you will be guided through the steps. The report is structured in sections that follow the logic of the Annex of the Interoperable Europe Act. You can start now, save your work and finish later on.

The report will be published after a SPAM check of the Commission. The Commission is not checking the quality or correctness of the proposal. Your personal data will not be publicly available on the portal. The Commission can use your personal data to check that you are working for the entity that your are providing the report for.

The future of the GovTech Connect Community



Two complementary initiatives



GovTech Connect will become a **dedicated initiative under the PSTW umbrella**, focusing more on startups and GovTech, while PSTW will primarily publish content for the public sector and academia.



Two Collections – one entry point



Users will find two distinct Collections, linked via a **shared landing page**. This will ensure easy navigation for startups, the public sector, and academia.








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
