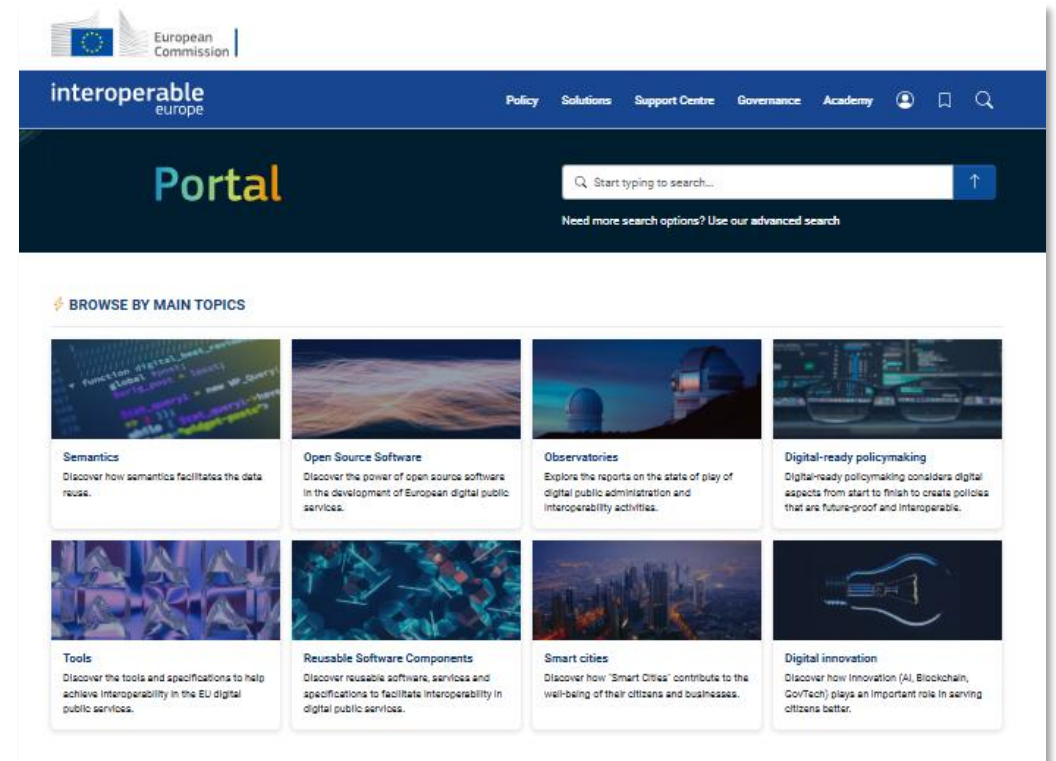
Introduction to the Portal

What type of content can I contribute to the Portal

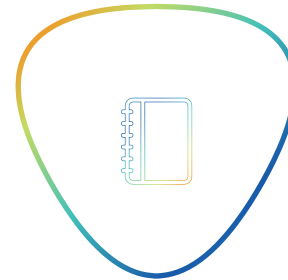
All content included on the Portal must be accessible and reusable by everyone

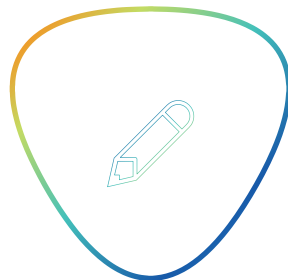

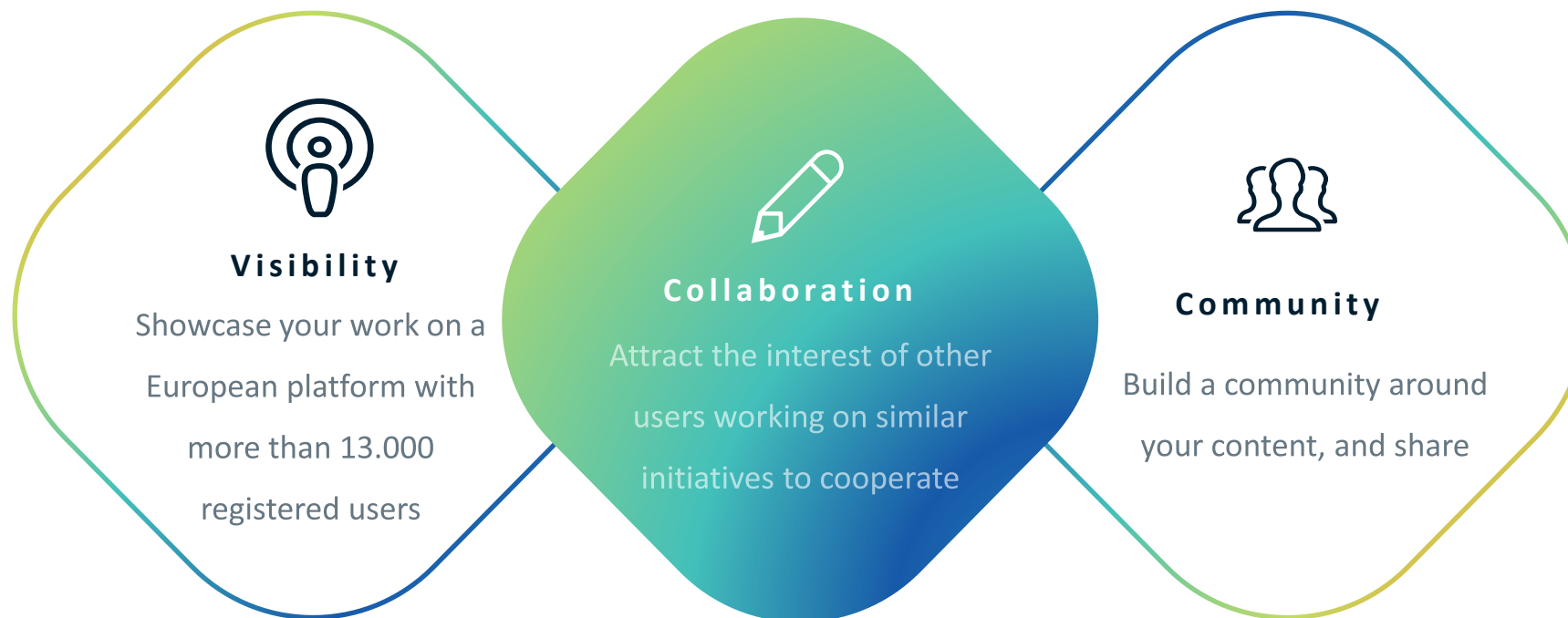

Why should I contribute to the Portal

Once you have signed in on the Portal, you can add content to the platform:
