### Governance

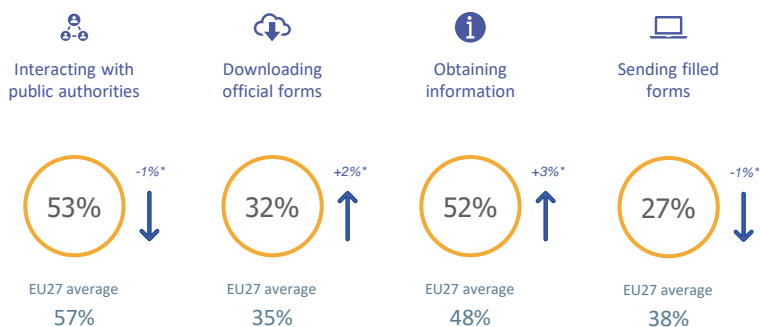
The new [Ministry of Digital Governance](#) brings together all the Information Technology and Telecommunications infrastructure related to the provision of digital services for citizens and businesses.

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

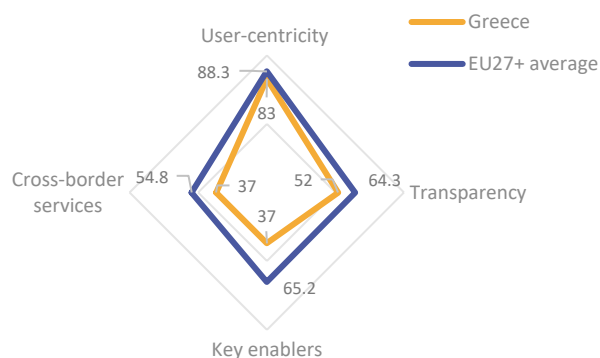

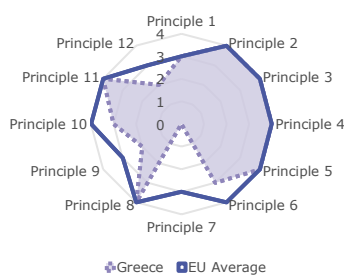
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



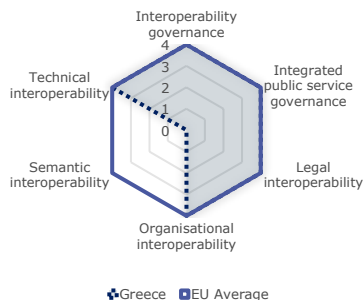
