

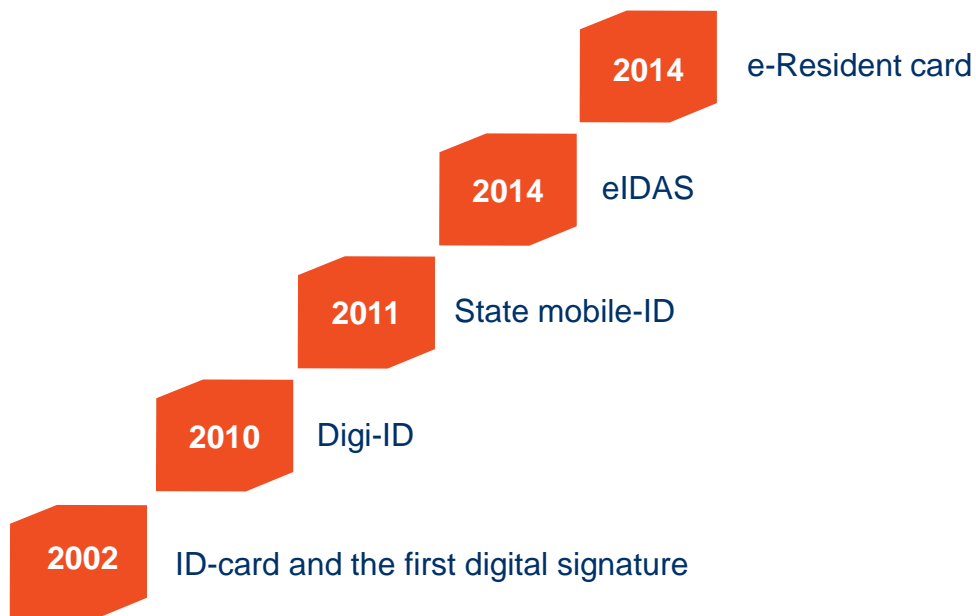

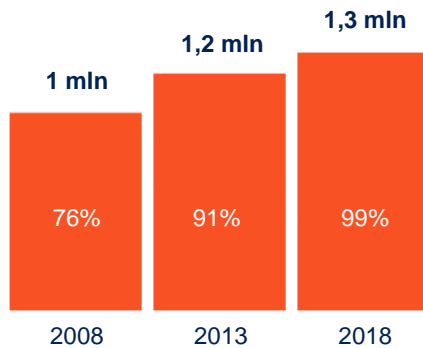

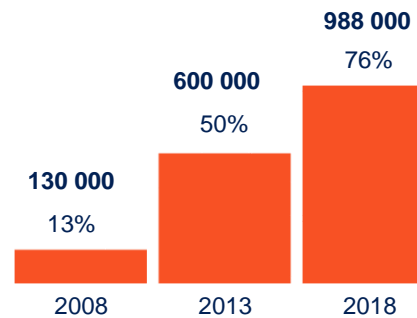

- 98% of public services are available as e-services
- 43% of voters use i-voting
- Implementing ASiC-E container format
- Dealing with legacy – container & signature formats and weak algorithms
- Supporting neighbours eID
- e-Resident card
- eIDAS implementation
